Klaserie

The Klaserie Game Reserve was established in 1972 as part of the greater Kruger National Park. It is one of the largest private reserves in South Africa, being 60,000 hectares (or 148,000 acres). This vast tract of preserved land has some beautiful trees and riverine vegetation near the magnificent Klaserie River. It has an open fenceless border to the Kruger National Park in the north, and the Timbavati to the south-east.

The Klaserie also protects sustainable populations of many endangered species such as wild dog, saddle-billed storks and southern ground hornbills. This is a raw wilderness experience. With limited lodges and vehicles, this is the original non-commercialised safari experience.

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Lodge Layout

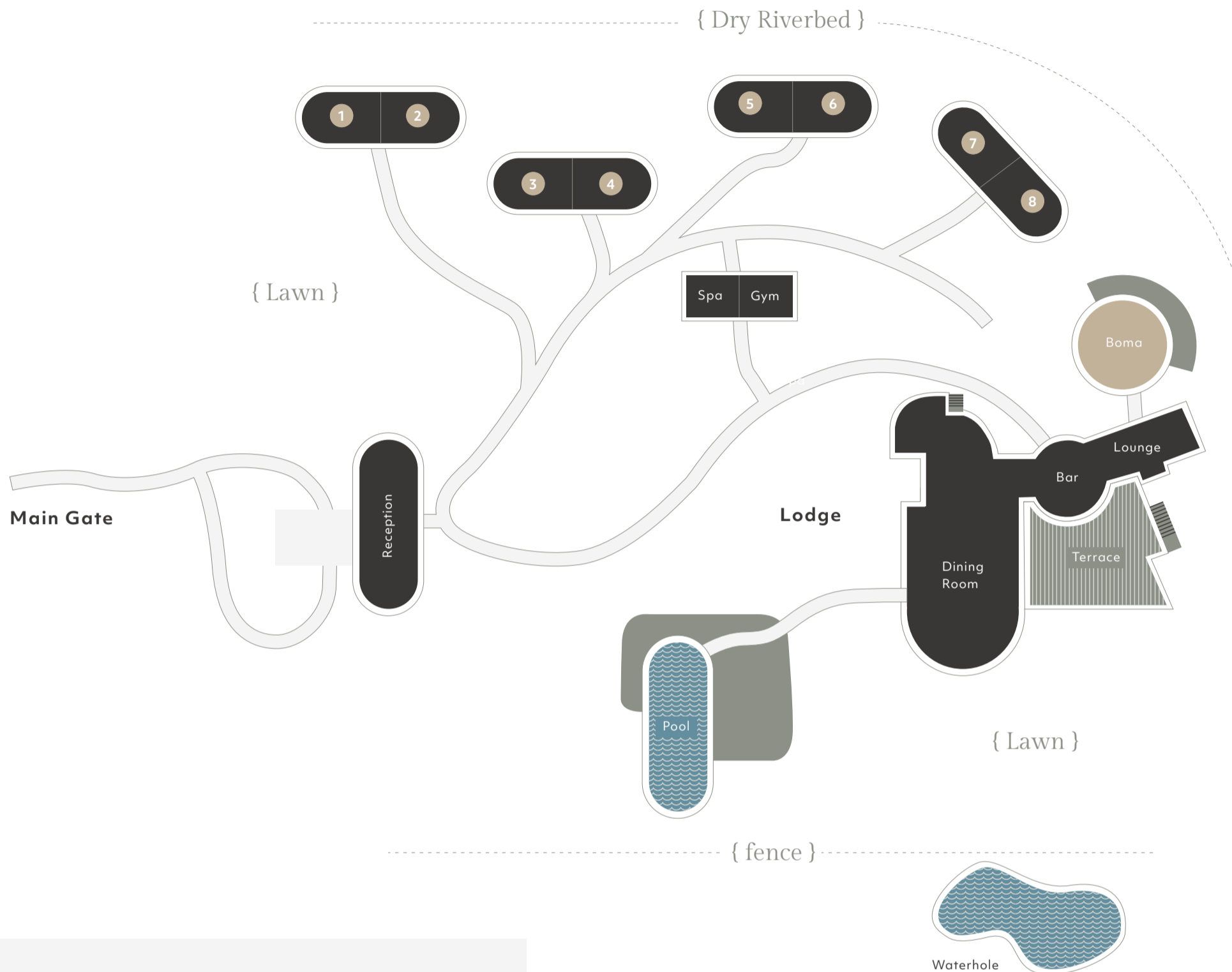

GETTING THERE

Travel Options

Simbavati Camp George is ±60 to 90 minutes from Hoedspruit Eastgate Airport, and can be accessed by car on gravel roads.

±6½ to 7 hours' drive from Johannesburg N1 via Polokwane (recommended route) or via Dullstroom, and 2 to 3 hours from Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport or Hazyview.
