The understated elegance of the décor, the views and the attention to your comfort is a perfect mix to make your safari extra special.


The thatched main area has an open dining area, bar and various small lounges overlooking an active waterhole.



LOCATION

Ghoha Hills Savuti Lodge is ideally positioned on the edges of the Ghoha Hills in Savuti within the Chobe National Park approximately 150km south west of Kasane and 230km north east of Maun.





HOW TO GET THERE

4 X 4 VEHICLE

Road transfer is approximately 3 hours taking you through parts of Chobe, some local villages and different 4 x 4 terrains. Transfers can be pre-booked at time of reservation from Kasane Airport. ($Minimum\ 2\ people$)

Maun Airport	50 minutes in air plus 40 minutes road transfer

GENERAL TRAVEL INFO

MALARIA

Malaria is prevalent during the mid to late rainy season (January to May) but one should always take precautionary measures. Consult your local GP for preventative malaria prophylaxis. Use insect repellents, sleep under mosquito nets and during the day wear light long sleeved clothing.

WEATHER

The Chobe region has two very distinct seasons and experiences hot, wet summer and cool, dry winters.

The rainfall period occurs November to April and daytime temperatures during this period average at 35 degrees Celsius.

During May to September the days are moderate, but the mornings and evenings are cold. Humidity in the Chobe area is low.

WHAT TO PACK

- Summer months are hot and humid. Cool cotton clothing advised
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Sun hat, sunglasses and sunblock
- Cameras and extra SD Cards and binoculars
- Light, neutral coloured clothing
- Bathing suit
- Warm jackets essential in winter (May Oct)
- Beanie and gloves the mornings are cold during winter
