Overlooking Tshwene Valley, Laluka combines the romance of a bush lodge with a contemporary modern architecture. The interiors emphasize space & light while the lodge features wood and natural fibres in a palette of charcoal, grey and brown.

Laluka boasts six spacious suites each with glass windows overlooking the valley and a spacious wooden deck with a private plunge pool. Ensuite bathrooms comprise both an indoor & outdoor shower and a freestanding bath. Available in each suite a personal bar station and a private sitting area.

Inspired by the surroundings, Laluka is designed to be a sustainable element of the complex ecosystem that is the African bush. Our conservation work aims to protect our environment and ensuring that our footprint is as subtle as possible.



The operation of our farm is based upon sustainable & organic farming methods. Everything is grown organically using only natural fertilizers and pest control solutions. We mainly grow vegetables & fruits and the farm is home to a variety of animals like cows, sheep & goats, chickens, quails & pigs. Equipped with our own butchery & passionate beekeepers, each thing we do is aimed at creating a sanctuary for the senses.

# YOUR JOURNEY

### WHEN

#### November to April:

It will be hot & humid with temperatures averaging 25 to 30 degrees.

It is considered to be the raining season and there can be occasional thunderstorms.

#### May to October:

It will be drier and cooler with temperatures that can reach as low as 3 degrees at night and a comfortable 24 degrees during the day.

It is considered to be the dry season.

#### November to April:

Comfortable summer clothing

Warm sweater/jersey for cooler mornings

#### May to October:

Comfortable lightweight clothing

Windbreaker/Winter fleece for game drives
