



Located in the wildlife rich Klaserie Private Nature Reserve, nThambo Tree Camp is an eco-friendly camp with 5 wooden treehouse style chalets resting on raised platforms. This is an intimate camp with a difference – it's part luxury, part adventure. The décor creates an air of simple luxury and it's the ideal camp for relaxation. And the adventure part? Well, it feels like you're in a treehouse. Expect hyenas to walk under your treehouse and don't be alarmed when you hear the elephants devouring the tree adjacent to your room.

EXPECT THE FOLLOWING:

- The opportunity to explore a less commercial private reserve that shares unfenced borders with the Timbavati and Kruger National Park.
- The camp is open which means predators and other wildlife might come strolling through camp during the night.
- Rangers will take you to sightings outside of the designated safari times if there is something of interest happening.
- A friendly, relaxed atmosphere. The type of place where it's okay to put your feet up on the table, watch the game at the waterhole and blog away while making use of the WiFi.
- A camp that is eco-friendly.
- Traffic at the waterhole and the possibility of elephants drinking from the pool.
- A well-stocked bar.
- Knowledgeable, qualified rangers who will keep you entertained with their stories.
- A refreshing splash pool overlooking the savannah.
- Daily game drives in an area prolific with predators.
- If you're lucky you may get the chance to see the famous Ross Pride of lions and their cubs.
