	March 2024	- We are hard at work to get a professional camera set into each of our Explorer-Collection camps for guests to use on a complimentary basis. As soon as they are available and in camp, we will advise, although for now, this has been removed from the relevant pages in this manual.
	May 2024	- We are please to advised that the helicopter supplements for the routes between Duba and Selinda, and Sitatunga and Selinda, have been reduced. - Sitatunga Private Island is a water-based activity safari camp offering boating and mokoro activities (water level dependent). KENYA	June 2023	- The scheduled air transfer rate between Nairobi Wilson Airport and Mara Expedition Camp is now available and has been added to the relevant page.
	August 2023	- We maintain a high level of flexibility when it comes to check-out times at our camps. However, due to some scheduled air transfer schedules, there are instances where we may kindly request guests to check out of their rooms by 9:00am. In such situations, our lodges and camps are set up to ensure that guests can utilise the facilities located in the central area. This includes access to the internet, the provision of complimentary drinks and lunch in the event of any unexpected delays, and access to hides or other activities if available.
	October 2023	- Mara Toto Camp will reopen for the 2024 safari season on 1 July as a Réserve-Collection camp and be renamed Mara Toto Tree Camp – rates manuals have been updated with the rates accordingly. - There has been an increase in the Maasai Mara National Reserve Fees as well as applicable child ages. The respective pages reflecting these rates have been revised.
	January 2024	- We've revised the rate notes for Mara Expedition Camp and Mara Nyika Camp to provide clearer information on the maximum number of guests that can be accommodated in the 2-bedroom family tent/ suite. - Please note that during the low season, the scheduled flight from Nairobi Wilson Airport departs in the morning. Please consider this when booking connecting flights and air transfers.
	March 2024	- Following the planned refurbishment in April, Mara Nyika Camp will open with one additional suite bringing the total number of rooms to 4 guest suites The relevant page has been updated.
	April 2024	- A new Bell 505 helicopter is now available for transfers between Nairobi, our Maasai Mara-based camps, and Ol Donyo Lodge. The helicopter is based at Ol Donyo Lodge and offers guests the opportunity to enjoy scenic flights around the Chyulu Hills, Amboseli, and Mount Kilimanjaro. All applicable information and rates has been added to this manual for you. - The above-mentioned new helicopter excursion page has been updated. The Amboseli excursion, including a Great Plains safari drive, now offers guests the option to return to the Donyo Lodge by safari drive in addition to the option of returning by helicopter. - We evaluate each booking to ensure we deliver the best possible safari experience to all our guests in camp.
- Our camps are located in wildlife zones that are not fenced in and there are no child care facilities in our camps. Parents/guardians must be watchful of and responsible for their children at all times.
- Our child policy summary in terms of wildlife experience activities is as follow:

BOTSWANA & ZIMBABWE

- Scheduled wildlife viewing activities, including safari drives, guided walks, and power boating, are available to guests from 6 years when accompanied by their parents or guardians. Canoe and mekoro activities specifically welcome guests aged 8 years and above.

KENYA

- Guests of all ages are welcome to participate in all scheduled wildlife viewing activities.
- Walking activities are not possible at our Maasai Mara based camps. The walking activity at ol Donyo Lodge is available to all guests, at manager and guide's discretion.
- Horse riding is available to guests from 12 years old and riders need to have previous experience riding horses. No beginners.
