Overview

Location

Vast and unimpeded views of the Zambezi River are complimented by surrounding indigenous flora that encompass a tranquil, peaceful, and private sanctuary, placed within a convenient and central location in Victoria Falls.














Gymnasium

Beauty Spa



Swimming Pool

A 34m infinity pool in the foreground of the main area merges with the horizon and offers a cool oasis under the shade of towering trees. At night the pool area transforms into a starlit wonderland, with the use of cleverly illuminated pebbles and lighting.

From game viewing to helicopter flights, and river cruises to historical tours of the vibrant town, there is much to see and do in Victoria Falls. The tours and activities desk offers an invaluable information asset to help guests plan their stay and book their activities inhouse.

Restaurant

A large al fresco dining area under a canopy of trees offers an à la carte restaurant serving breakfast, lunch and dinner to hotel guests and day visitors. Its position offers stunning garden views sweeping down and out onto the flowing waters of the Zambezi River. The cuisine reflects the natural setting, using fresh, local ingredients to create unique fusion fare. The restaurant also offers in-room dining.

Outdoor Bar

Set under a canopy of trees in the main area, the outdoor bar serves a selection of local and imported beverages, wines, cocktails, speciality coffees and fresh fruit juices daily from 10 am to 10 pm.

Daily Afternoon Tea

Included in their stay, guests can enjoy complimentary daily afternoon tea between 3.30 pm and 4.30 pm. This includes a variety of sweet treats, teas and coffees served near the restaurant and offering a relaxing Zambezi River view.

Riverside Dining

The Riverside Dining Experience offers hotel guests authentic African-style barbeque dining, within an unparalleled setting on the Zambezi River. Under a twinkling canopy of stars, and illuminated by lanterns, guests are treated to an authentic barbeque-style dinner, perfectly positioned within the hotel's lush gardens, alongside the palm-fringed banks of the tranquil and serene river.

The experience takes place between 18h00 and 20h30 and is available to all in-house guests of the Palm River Hotel and Ilala Lodge Hotel throughout the year, weather conditions permitting. The event includes a 3-course barbeque dinner, a welcome drink, return transfers return transfers for Ilala Lodge Hotel guests and local entertainment.

Ra-Ikane River Cruise

The luxury Ra-Ikane River Cruise offers breakfast, birdwatching, lunch and sunset cruises on the Zambezi River.

The cruises follow a circular route around the river islands to provide guests with a panoramic view of the upper Zambezi River and the wildlife and birdlife available.

Each Ra-Ikane boat has its own crew, made up of a friendly and knowledgeable captain, guide and waiter to ensure a tranquil and memorable experience on board.

Adventure

Victoria Falls is deemed 'Africa's Adventure Capital' delivering everything from helicopter flights above the Falls, highwire activities over the 120m gorges or white-water rafting the rapids beyond the World Wonder, Victoria Falls waterfall. The Rooms


Design


In room Dining



The Palm River Hotel offers two fullyserviced wheelchair accessible rooms located on the ground floor closest to the Main Area.






Presidential Suite

The Palm River Villa Inclusive of 3 bedrooms

Offering the pinnacle of private residing at the Palm River Hotel is the exclusive Palm River Villa. Made up of an Executive Suite with ensuite bathroom, private lounge and guest bathroom, a Honeymoon Suite with ensuite bathroom attached to a main lounge and kitchen area and a Twin Deluxe Room with ensuite bathroom.

The Palm River Villa is complete with a kitchen, dining area, spacious lounge, car park, private swimming pool with an expansive patio and garden; shared only with free-roaming wildlife that frequent the lush lawns. The Villa allows for families or small travel groups to have their own exclusive space, while immersed in the riverside location of the Palm River Hotel.





Sustainability

The Palm River Hotel is committed to fulfilling sustainable practises from early construction right through to everyday operations. The hotel strives to decrease its environmental footprint and increase ongoing sustainability where possible.

Environmental preservation

Environmental impact assessments have been carried out through every stage of the hotel's development to ensure as small an environmental footprint as possible. Contracting teams found ways of minimising destruction of the land and adapting where necessary to accommodate the changing water levels while, at the same time, preserving the many indigenous trees and natural wildlife habitats with which the property is blessed.

Energy Conservation

The hotel is powered on a unique hybrid system combining solar power with hydroelectricity supplied by the powerful flow of the Zambezi River. Hot water supplies are provided by solar heated water tanks that heat-exchange with air conditioning plants for maximum efficiency. There is an allowance for the future addition of a solar farm on the site to cater for the hotel's power needs ensuring that the Palm River Hotel is truly a green entity.

Water Conservation

With consideration for its surroundings, the hotel has installed a sustainable borehole system equipped with its own water purification system.











Recycling and Waste Reduction

Where possible, the hotel endeavours to reuse the amount of single-use plastic, plastic bottles and aluminium cans throughout. Water purification systems supply safe and clean drinking water in glass bottles to allow for reusable and refillable water supplies. The hotel's recycling efforts include a glass crushing machine, while plastics, aluminium and paper are sorted into correct waste and passed on to the Victoria Falls Recycling Project for processing and re-use.

Sustainability in food

All biodegradable waste matter is carefully sorted and placed into on-site composting systems that allow for organic breakdown and can be re-used as organic fertiliser for selfgrown vegetables and herbs. In addition, the hotel sources local and season produce to add to the menu to further enhance efforts for a more sustainable food supply.

The Palm River Hotel proudly sources homegrown vegetables, herbs and spices from its in-house vegetable plantation. The abundant source of natural produce is fuelled by organic fertiliser produced on-site and ensures a fresh and consistent supply for use within the hotel restaurant.



Corporate Social Responsibility

The Palm Hospitality Group Foundation

The PHG Foundation was formed in 2022, combining years of successfully completed community projects by Ilala Lodge Hotel and more recently, with the likeminded and dynamic employees of the Palm River Hotel. Together, the PHG Foundation forms a passionate committee endeavouring to bring about meaningful and practical solutions to aid the local community of Victoria Falls.

The PHG Foundation has completed multiple community and responsible tourism projects covering environmental preservation, recycling, community support, wildlife protection, local fundraisers and numerous other initiatives that aid the community and preserve the rich cultural heritage of Victoria Falls.

Wildlife Conservation

PHG Foundation supports the Victoria Falls Anti-Poaching Unit (VFAPU) - a non-profit organization dedicated to the conservation of local wildlife and natural resources in Victoria Falls. VFAPU tries to protect wildlife and habitats from poacher pressure (subsistence and commercial), rescues and rehabilitates animals injured by human interference and educates schools and communities on human and animal conflict. The PHG Foundation makes monthly donations towards the organisation as well as supports in major fundraiser events, such as annual golf days. Money raised goes directly to the Victoria Falls Anti-Poaching Units, dedicated to the pertinent conservation of wildlife within Victoria Falls.

Humanitarian Support

The PHG Foundation works with several community projects and non-government organisations that provide support and care within Victoria Falls town. These often include ground assistance, sponsorship, donations to local schools, pensioners homes and the Maternity and Paediatric Art & Play therapy ward at Victoria Falls Hospital.







Environmental Preservation

Every first Friday of the month, a team of Palm River Hotel and Ilala Lodge Hotel staff members take to the local streets, carparks and public areas of town and participate in a community clean up. The teams collect litter and sweep areas in a bid to maintain and preserve the wonderful tourist town of Victoria Falls.

With care for local natural habitats, the hotel takes great pride in ensuring surrounding National Parks are free from harmful litter. Not only does this aesthetically spoil the natural surroundings, but litter can also be exceptionally harmful to the wildlife and birdlife that roam Victoria Falls.

As part of the hotel's community involvement, Palm River and Ilala Lodge Hotel have colletively installed over 20 litter bins throughout the town and within the pathways along the Victoria Falls Rainforest walk. The bins enable a safe place for guests to discard of litter, while also deterring baboons and monkeys from foraging and tipping out items from the previous plastic bins.

Sustainable Waste Management Initiative

Among many achievements, the PHG Foundation proudly introduced a sustainable waste management initiative, presented to the Greenline Africa Trust and the Victoria Falls Recycling Project.

This community initiative is made up of various events and projects that endeavour to better the future of green development within Victoria Fall through sustainable waste disposal and recycling of goods.
