THE EXPERIENCE



Leleshwa Camp is set up in Ol Derekesi Conservancy on the Mara Reserve boundary and overlooking the Sand River, a part of the Mara that is first to receive the vast herds each year as they cross the border from Tanzania. The area between the Sand River and the Tanzania border has possibly the lowest vehicle density of any part of the Mara ecosystem, meaning true privacy on game drives. Remote and topographically varied, the picturesque area has a wide variety of resident game throughout the year.

- Traditional tented camp in a private Conservancy.
- True exclusivity in the bush – with only two camps on the Conservancy, vehicle density is low giving you true privacy on game drives.
- In the heart of the action – the best that Kenya has to offer on your doorstep.
- Leleshwa Camp is available on a shared or exclusive basis.
- A booking for 8 adult guests, min 2 nights guarantees exclusive use, if there are no other confirmed bookings.

- Enjoy activities that each area has to offer, including day & night game drives, bush walks, village & school visits, in-depth interaction with local communities, balloon and helicopter rides, swimming and fishing.

- Single camp with 7 Luxury Suites (bedroom, lounge, bathroom)
- 4 x Luxury Suites: Double + daybed
- 3 x Luxury Suites: Double/Twin + daybed
- Daybeds can be used as an additional single bed to form a triple

THE CAMP





LUXURY GUEST TENTS

- Made from heavy duty rip-stop canvas with insect proof door and window lining
- Set on padded earthen platforms
- Verandah with a table and chairs
- En-suite bathroom facilities
- Tea & coffee station with snacks
- All beds have cotton linen, duvets (comforters) and heavy blankets.
- A hot water bottle is provided in the evening.

BATHROOM

- Wash table with hot & cold running water
- Flushing ceramic toilets
- Shower with hot & cold running water
- Wardrobe with hanging space
- Guest amenities: shampoo, conditioner, body lotion, vanity kit, sewing kit, shower cap

LIGHTING AND POWER

- Solar powered lighting available 24hrs – verandah, bedside tables & overhead in the bedroom, shower, toilet and over the wash table.
- Flashlights
- 240V charging facilities in each bedroom and in the main lounge.
- Lanterns illuminate the paths at night and guests are escorted to and from their tents.



DINING AND LOUNGE

- Separate Dining and Lounge tents
- Breakfast and lunch are served in the dining area or al fresco under the shade of the trees.
- Picnic breakfast and/or lunch can be served out on game drives.
- Continental-style cuisine caters to a variety of dietary tastes and requirements.
- Dinner is served around a large dining table, 'dining-party style' in the Dining tent or under the stars. Separate tables & private dining can be arranged.
- Exclusive use: Menus can be agreed with you in advance.

OL DEREKESI CONSERVANCY



The area between the Sand River and the Tanzania border has possibly the lowest vehicle density of any part of the Mara ecosystem, meaning true privacy on game drives in the jewel in Kenya's safari crown. Remote and topographically varied, the picturesque area has a wide variety of resident game to search for, regardless of where the migrating herds have reached.

CONSERVANCY HIGHLIGHTS

- A level of freedom and exclusivity that's rare in the Mara.
- Unrestricted access to both the Ol Derekesi Conservancy and the Maasai Mara National Reserve. Cross the Sand River into the Mara where you go further afield for a full day with picnic meals.
- Part of an exclusive group of top-end safari operators using the remote and less visited part of the Maasai Mara National Reserve, between the Sand River and the Tanzania border.
- The area is usually the first to receive the wildebeest migration (usually in June).
- Activities:
Day and night game drives on Ol Derekesi Conservancy, day game drives in the Maasai Mara Game Reserve, guided bush walks, Maasai school, village & market visits, Conservancy project visits, paddling, swimming and fishing in the Sand River.
