COMFORT FULLY SERVICED MOBILE TENTED SAFARI CAMP IN BOTSWANA

Endeavour Safaris offers several alternatives to travel through Africa, but in Botswana the best way to fully know this country, untouched, is by means of a safari tent in areas where you and your group may be the only guests!





The Concept of Adventure Camping in Comfort and Safety

Endeavour organizes fully serviced mobile tented camps: Tents to sleep in with en-suite toilet and shower (fully serviced), and a mess tent next to the kitchen; all set up in the heart of the wilderness!

Endeavour has no limitations, because we can visit and set up our camps wherever we go. Our camps are also accessible to children of any age, the elderly, and those with sensory and motor difficulties (people with disabilities).

These safaris have been designed in such a way as to ensure maximum comfort and respond to the demands for anyone who prefers a product more luxurious but still adventurous African style product. In our camps we set up large tents of 4.5 m x 3m x 2 to 2.5 m, built with a thick layer for insulation on the ground and a partition between the bedroom and private bathroom interior. The tents can be double, single or family (with 1 or 2 children). The tents have large windows with mosquito gauze.


In the bathroom there is a chemical toilet and a hot 're-fillable' bucket shower, and for those with mobility problems, are equipped with chairs with padded seat and folding armrests for easy transfer from wheelchair to shower or toilet.

In the bathroom is also a small linen closet with shelves, a mirror and containers for soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, brush, comb We provide towels and amenities such as soap, shampoo and insect repellent.

We also provide high-density mattresses, pillows, quilts, sheets, and during the winter, blankets and hot water bottle.

Between the beds there is a small table with a light and rechargeable battery. At the entrance of the tent there is a water container which is filled by our staff every morning and evening to wash your hands and face and clean your teeth.

The camp is set up with a mess tent, which includes a dining table and buffet table, and a coffee station which is available all day. The table for lunch and dinner is prepared by our camp staff with porcelain plates, glasses for water and wine, and metal cutlery.

The meals are prepared by our brilliant bush chefs on the fire and our menus include a variety of foods, including chicken, beef, pork and lamb, pasta, rice, potatoes, cooked and raw vegetables and fruits in season. Daily, our chefs prepare fresh bread and cakes for dessert and surprise birthday celebrations.

These safaris are organized with a minimum of 2 vehicles: one vehicle for passengers and the local guide, and a back-up vehicle for equipment, supplies and camp staff. The back-up vehicle departs before our clients, providing them with the required to prepare the camp and meals before the clients arrive.

Our staff efficiently ensure the cleanliness and order of the camp and the tents at all times, and they take

For photographic safaris, our vehicles can accommodate between 8 and 12 people and are equipped with a first aid kit, some field guides and books about animals of the region, and a spare set of mechanical parts.

Endeavour Safaris vehicles are 4x4, allowing them to go off-road. They are comfortable and very spacious, partly open with the ability to close them during the rainy season: either with removable windows or heavy canvas. Our vehicles are open on the sides, allowing you to easily spot animals, and providing a complete and wild experience during your photographic safari.

All our vehicles have an energy converter for charging cameras, batteries, electric wheelchairs and any other electrical devices (inverter converts 12V to 110V or 220V). The vehicles are also equipped with refrigerators to keep drinks cool, especially during the hot summer season.

All our vehicles are equipped with a hydraulic lift to allow access to the vehicle, even for those who use



All our guides are professional and licensed, registered with the relevant authority. During your safari, you will always be accompanied by your guide for the duration of the itinerary. Our guides are chosen for their deep knowledge of the African bush, and are dedicated to ensuring you enjoy your travel and safari experience. Detailed information on the history of the various locations, as well as information on the local fauna and flora will be provided during the safari. All safaris are conducted in English.



AFRICAN CONDITIONS

Please note that itineraries depend on site conditions. Travelling in Africa can lead to the unexpected and any participants in our safaris must have a taste for adventure.

Travelling in remote areas you may encounter problems like bad roads conditions, bad weather, mechanical failures, or your vehicle can become stuck in mud and water, which could delay and change the course of the safari. This is also part of the experience and adventure travel in Africa!

Therefore, participants should have a certain spirit of flexibility when choosing this kind of trip.
