

WHY IS SWAKOPMUND IDEAL

as a destination

Swakopmund is on the main road link between Etosha, Kunene and Damaraland in the north and Namib Naukluft Park, Sossusvlei, Aus and the Fish River Canyon in the south. Walvis Bay is just 20mins drive down the B2 highway and is the major harbour town of Namibia and also the industrial and logistics gateway to Africa. There are numerous Car Hire companies both in Windhoek & Swakopmund that offer a vast range of vehicles from small "run-arounds" to off-road 4x4 Land Rover Defenders. Many attractions are accessible for self-drive travellers, however most areas are ecologically sensitive and therefore require MET permits (available in Swakopmund and a fee will need to be paid). Certain areas may be accessed by self drive tourists however an experienced guide would be recommended, due to remoteness of areas and to assist in finding specific plants, animals and natural attractions.

Many different full day tours leave from Swakopmund daily. Guests are collected by individual tour guides and taken to places of interest. Tours are normally between 5 - 8hrs in

length and will include a basic midday meal and mineral water during the day. Tourists can therefore stay in Swakopmund and visit the most sought after Namibian tourist attractions in the comfort of a small plane, tour bus or private self-drive.

Restaurants

There are a large number of restaurants in Swakopmund, for almost every kind of meal that the hungry traveller may want. Small intimate bistro's, to larger venues catering to tour groups and business travellers, but also the variety of foods available ranges across a vast number of international cuisines, and from fine dining at the famous Wreck Restaurant and seafood at the popular Tug Restaurant to exquisite sushi at the Ocean Cellar Strand Hotel or the best meat restaurant in town At the Dome.







Bars

Swakopmund has a number of popular pubs, sports bars, a night club and a casino and entertainment centre. Visitors to the town can choose from a range pubs such as the Brauhaus, the Brewer and Butcher (with their own micro-brewery), or the ever famous Kücki's Pub which attracts a large number of loyal patrons every year. Recently the Locker Room (Sports Bar & Lounge) opened at The Dome, and this is a popular venue for those who like to watch sports and share a drink with their friends. Ideal for travellers who do not want to miss their favourite sports teams fixtures.

Indoor Sports & Conference Centre


