


Namibia has recently become one of the most popular tourism destinations in the world ...


In 2014 Namibia was voted as the "fastest growing tourism destination in the world" and Namibia remains an African destination of choice which offering travellers not only value for money but safety as well as a sense of awe and inspiration. Tourists are provided with high levels of hospitality, pristine natural environments (protected by law) and a sense of safety not available in many destinations of the world today.

Tourist numbers, from Africa, to Namibia are increasing year on year, specially from Angola and South Africa, and in September 2016 a record high for the number of foreigners arriving in Namibia was recorded.

Most tourists visiting Namibia come from Angola, South Africa, Germany, United States and Portugal. The most popular months for foreign visitors are June - September, making up 42% of the total annual tourism market. December is the most popular month for local tourists to visit Swakopmund.








Where in the world is Namibia?

Namibia, is situated along the south western coastline of Africa. The Namibian northern Atlantic seaboard is popularly known as the Skeleton Coast whereas the southern coastline is often referred to as the Diamond Coast. It shares borders with South Africa, Botswana, Zambia, and Zimbabwe. The Orange River marks the southern border of Namibia with South Africa and in the north the Kunene and the Okavango Rivers form part of the northern border with Angola



Namibia is regularly featured on top 10 destination lists in various media. Not only is Namibia desirable as a picturesque destination with boundless natural beauty but travelling to Namibia is more importantly affordable, safe and provides a vast array of different travel experiences.


Namibia's Premier Tourism Hub **Swakopmund**

Situated centrally along the Atlantic coastline of Namibia,

Swakopmund is the main town through which all tourists travelling in Namibia have to pass. The town links travel routes from Etosha in the North, Windhoek in the East and Sossusvlei in the south, and for decades has served travellers by providing a variety of upmarket accommodation establishments, unique desert activities & experiences, shopping and sightseeing opportunities not available along the long and winding travel routes that crisscross this vast country.

A new International Airport was opened in 2016 just 40kms outside Swakopmund and a few kilometers outside Walvis Bay.

A massive new harbour expansion project is in progress between Walvis Bay and Swakopmund and the area is booming as the new "gateway" into Africa.





From the mountains to the sea, from the cool wet coastline to the hot arid desert of the Namib, from the unique history of the town to the pristine countryside, SWAKOPMUND has something for everyone.

The position of the town makes this the main tourist link between the north, central and southern regions of Namibia.

With a mild climate almost all-year-round, SWAKOPMUND provides a welcome respite for travellers, from the harsh dry heat of the Etosha Pan, Sossusvlei and Namibian interior.



HERITAGE

Swakopmund was founded as harbour town for the former German colony in August 1894. The last ship ever to reach Swakopmund harbour arrived during September 1914.

Since 1915 all harbor activities had been shifted to the natural deep sea harbor at Walvis Bay, which is situated just 30 km to the south.

Where Swakopmund should have become a proper ghost town, it is thriving like hardly any other place on the continent.



IN THE SURROUNDING REGION

Ideally located, Swakopmund is central to Namibia's major iconic tourist attractions. Along the main road link between Etosha, Kunene and Damaraland in the north and Namib Naukluft Park, Sossusvlei, Aus and the Fish River Canyon in the south, Swakopmund is the main connection.


Walvis Bay, just 20mins drive down the B2 highway is the major harbour town of Namibia and therefore the industrial and logostics gateway to Africa. Swakopmund in contrast is renown for her diverse community culture a "melting pot" of old colonial times, modern upcoming young Namibian entreprenuers and a selection of talented creative people.






Guests are collected by individual tour guides and taken to places of interest booked directly with tour operators.

Tours are normally between 5 - 8hrs in length and will include a basic midday meal and mineral water during the day.









Many attractions are accessible for self-drive travellers, however most areas are ecologically sensitive and therefore require MET permits (available in Swakopmund and a fee will need to be paid). Certain areas may be accessed by self drive tourists however an experienced guide would be recommended, due to remoteness of areas and to assist in finding specific plants, animals and natural attractions.










Bookings can also be made through travel agents and hotel receptions.








Guests are collected by the individual tour guides and taken to places of interest .Guests are also able to walk or self drive to various activity centres.


RESTAURANTS & BARS

There are a large number of restaurants in Swakopmund, for almost every kind of meal that the hungry traveller may want. Small intimate bistro's, to larger venues catering to tour groups and business travellers, but also the variety of foods available ranges across a vast number of international cuisines, and from fine dining at the famous Wreck Restaurant and seafood at the popular Tug Restaurant to exquisite sushi at the Ocean Cellar Strand Hotel or the best meat restaurant in town At the Dome.

Swakopmund has a number of popular pubs, sports bars, a night club and a casino and entertainment centre. Visitors to the town can choose from a range pubs such as the Brauhaus, the Brewer and Butcher (with their own micro-brewery), or the ever famous Kücki's Pub which attracts a large number of loyal patrons every year. Recently the Locker Room (Sports Bar & Lounge) opened at The Dome, and this is a popular venue for those who like to watch sports and share a drink with their friends. THE DOME - INDOOR SPORTS CENTRE


The Dome, Swakopmund is a one of a kind business, lifestyle, event centre. It was completed in early 2016 and has since become an outstanding feature on the Swakopmund skyline. The Dome, provides an ideal venue for trade exhibitions, large sports and entertainment events, conferences and it even has a luxury suite hotel (BON Hotel Swakopmund). This multifunctional facility serves the local community as well as business and holiday travellers all year round and has hosted major sports events, music concerts and both international and local Trade Exhibitions. There is also an Indoor Swimming Pool which is part of the state-of-the-art health and wellness centre in The Dome.

SHOPPING

In line with recent developments and increased growth in the Erongo Region, the first shopping mall has opened to the public in October 2016. Platz am Meer is the only shopping complex of it's kind along the Namibian coast and offers a range of popular new shops and restaurants as well as fast food outlets. The views from the front facade over Swakopomund are absolutely spectacular.

In and around Swakopmund town are many small interesting curio shops which cater specifically to the needs of tourists who are looking for authentic Namibian and African style products. Swakopmund also has large retail grocery stores providing the latest and most popular fresh and packaged goods for self drive tourists to stock up during their travels.











BUSINESS HUB

Business and Entrepreneurship is continually growing in Swakopmund, and the town has become the sought-after destination town for more locals and southern African business travellers than ever before. Not only for its numerous holiday and resort attractions but as a major centre for conference and trade exhibitions. The hospitality association states that Swakopmund can cater for up to 10 000 delegates.
