



LOCATION

Solio Lodge is nestled between Mount Kenya and the Aberdare Mountains on Solio Conservancy. The ranch spreads over 45,000 acres with a 19,000 acre wildlife conservancy. Solio is home to black and white rhinos that live in harmony with other wildlife, including lion, leopard and cheetah.

ACCOMMODATION

Solio has five individual cottages, one of which is a family unit with two en-suite bedrooms that accommodates up to five people. Each cottage has a large sitting area with an open fireplace. The en-suite bathrooms are enormous with double sinks, showers, baths, separate toilets and dressing areas. Each cottage has floor-to-ceiling glass windows and a large veranda from which guests can enjoy spectacular views of Mount Kenya.

FACILITIES

- In-room massage offering a variety of treatments
- All rooms have showers and baths
- Handmade Kenyan toiletries, dressing gowns, slippers and hair dryers in every room
- Fridge and safe in rooms

GIVING BACK

Solio Conservancy is internationally recognised as the most successful private rhino breeding sanctuary in Kenya. Each guest who stays at Solio pays conservation fees that go towards the conservation of the endangered white and black rhino as well as other species within the sanctuary.

Solio Lodge is also involved in education and health programmes in the local community. The Safari Collection has strong links to local schools around Solio Lodge and in the last two years our donors have completely rebuilt the Charles Wickham Honi Primary School and added a new classroom block at Leburra Primary School. The lodge is also heavily involved in the funding and improvements of the Mary Immaculate Shelter of Love, a local orphanage which is home to 32 children.

Solio is a gold rated eco-lodge, signifying that it operates under the strictest guidelines of sustainability and continually strives to leave as minimal an impact on its surroundings as possible.

















ACTIVITIES

Enjoy game drives within the conservancy. Guests can also go horseback riding, walking or cycling within Solio's Ranch. The lodge's location allows for easy access to Mount Kenya by helicopter and the Aberdares by road, for trout fishing. For more information read our activities and extras document.
