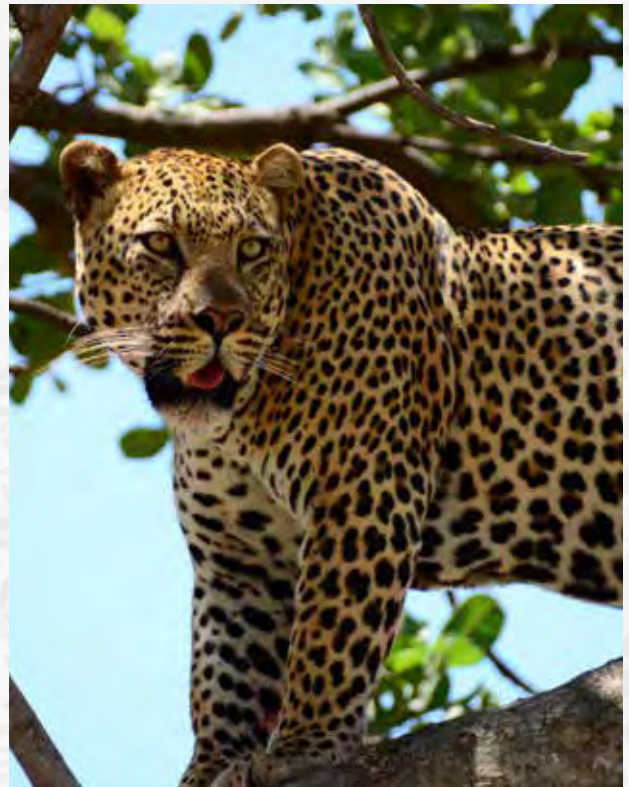


WHERE MAGIC IS MADE REAL

SERENELY YOURS

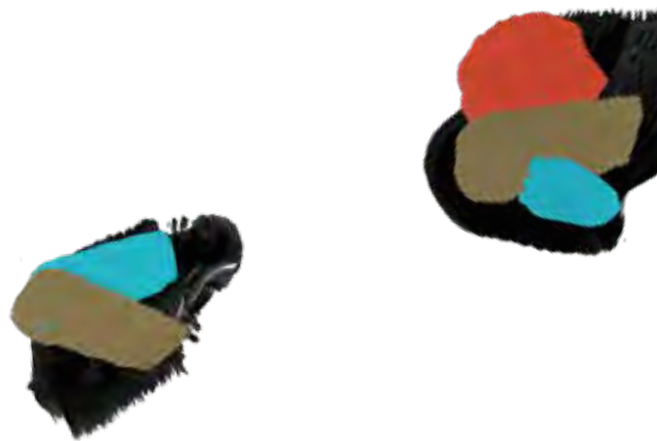

A place that not only gives privileged access to Kenya's wildest drama, but also provides protection and hope for the area's wildlife. So while you retreat to the serenity of Olarro's lodgings, Olarro Conservancy offers sanctuary for animal kind.

Recruited from local communities, our specially trained rangers are Olarro Conservancy's guardians. As well as tracking animals on behalf of guests, they also put their skills to work for the Kenyan Wildlife Service to help put a stop to poaching.

Our conservancy and its rangers play a big part in protecting many African animals. But we don't just stop at protection. Having undertaken threatened species surveys, Olarro Conservancy is also here to restore and enrich the ecosystem, with increased protection of endangered species.

We ensure that encounters with Africa's animals – species that migrate in millions and those on the brink of existence – never become extinct. Instead, rare glimpses will be replaced by enduring experiences.



UNRIVALLED SAFARI

See majestic lions laze and cheetahs prowl. Watch antelope bound across sun-scorched earth, or gargantuan elephant gatherings under the cover of darkness. Witness these Maasai Mara spectacles uninterrupted.

With our very own private conservancy, Olarro grants you exclusive access to rare and iconic African wildlife, day and night. Away from the crowds of public parks, you can capture the picture-perfect sighting, free from any other holidaymakers or vehicles.

WITNESS ONE OF NATURE'S GREATEST EVENTS

Sitting in the path of the wildebeest's annual migration, the Olarro Conservancy gives you a unique view of planet earth's wildest and grandest spectacle – the Great Migration.

Following in the wake of Africa's rains, more than 2 million wildebeest (accompanied by some 200,000 zebra and gazelle at times) cross countries and travel over 1,800 miles every year, searching for luscious grass. Their circular journey begins in Tanzania's southern Serengeti plains, heads north to Kenya's Maasai Mara, before turning back towards the south and returning to the Serengeti. This takes these tenacious creatures a full year to complete.

The crossing of the Mara River – one of the migration's most spectacular stages – takes place in the north, near Olarro. As each beast takes a leap of faith into the river's waters, they battle torrents and dodge the jaws of waiting crocodiles to reach fresh pastures in the Maasai Mara and our conservancy.

The lives of those who reside in our luxury lodges aren't the only ones who occupy our minds. We are also keen to look after the community around us. From building schools and boreholes to offering services and advice to help villages protect their livestock, we have undertaken a range of projects to protect local lives.

Our involvement has provided more than 2,000 people with fresh water; preserved cattle and livelihoods from parasites and Africa's wildlife, and powered homes with solar energy. We've created jobs, opened up healthcare and protected the community from wild neighbours as well as crime. Olarro's magic relies on its location. So it's essential that we take care of the land, animals and the community that surround us.







PLAN A TRIP THAT DEFIES DESCRIPTION

WHEN'S BEST TO VISIT?

The beauty of Olarro is that it is a holiday destination offering magic all year round. July to October is when Olarro and the surrounding Maasai Mara floods with life in the form of both the savannah's flora and the Great Migration. Witness the deluge of wildebeest, zebra and gazelle as they head north and into our conservancy and catch Kenya's top predators in action.

January to March is the dry season, when animals gather in large numbers around the remaining waterholes, making them easier to see. Whichever month you choose to visit Kenya, Olarro is a hive of activity season out and each experience will be an individual one.



HOW LONG SHOULD WE STAY?

Olarro is rich with experiences, both wild and luxurious, so there's no limit to how long you could spend here. Every day's different, and each one opens eyes to something new.

However, to make sure you don't miss out on the very essential spectacles – indulgent and untamed – we recommend a minimum stay of three nights.

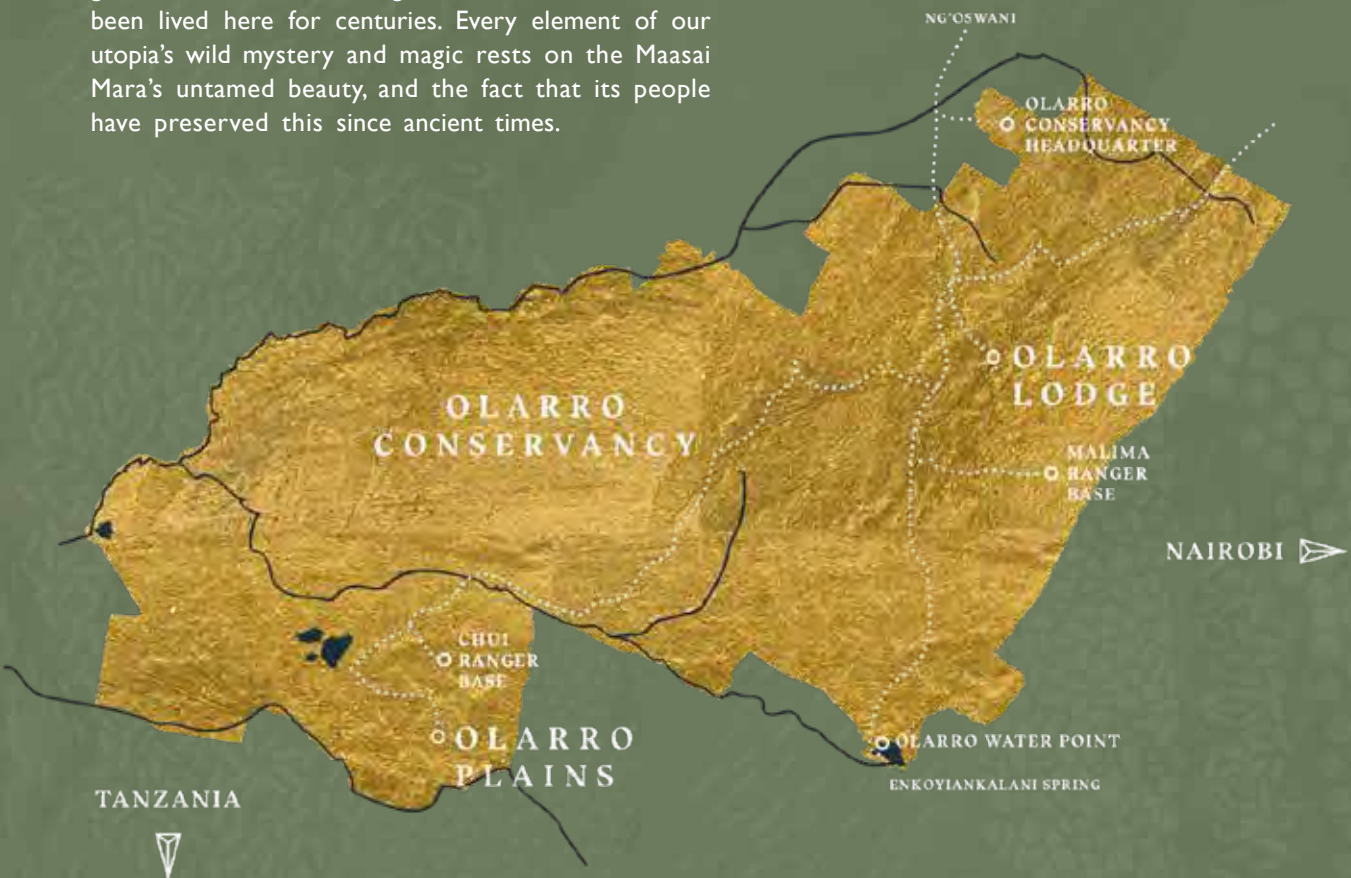


A WORLD AWAY FROM ANY OTHER

Olarro lies just over 120 miles west of Kenya's capital, Nairobi. The border with Tanzania is roughly 40 miles southwest from our 20,000-acre private wilderness. This places us at the heart of the Maasai Mara's action, even in the wildebeest's migratory path.

Olarro Lodge sits within a larger area owned by a local Maasai tribe – the Maji Moto Group Ranch. Here, in this 150,000-acre area and the lands beyond, these people have lived for hundreds of years in complete harmony with nature's raw forces and Africa's animals. Olarro Plains sits in the Siana Group Ranch.

As ethereal as a stay here feels, Olarro is very much grounded in its surroundings, in tune with how life has been lived here for centuries. Every element of our utopia's wild mystery and magic rests on the Maasai Mara's untamed beauty, and the fact that its people have preserved this since ancient times.
