SIMBAVATI FYNBOS ON SEA

DIRECTIONS

Fynbos Ridge is very easy to get to. It will take approx 5 hours from Cape Town, 45 minutes from George Airport and 3 to 3¹/₂ hours from Port Elizabeth.

DIRECTIONS FROM GEORGE AIRPORT /CAPE TOWN – FROM THE WEST

From George Airport, you take the road signposted to the N2. Then take the N2 in the direction of Knysna. You pass through the town of Wilderness.

Travel 27.8 km from the airport (from the airport or when you get onto the N2?) and turn right at the Sedgelinks signboard onto the Swartvlei Beach Road.

(Please note that if you find yourself travelling across the lake and into the town of Sedgefield, you have gone too far and you need to double back.)

Once on the Swartvlei Beach Road, you immediately turn right into the Sedgelinks parking (i.e. after only 90 metres). The entrance gate into Fynbos on Sea is on the right-hand side of the parking area.

Follow the paved road up the headland for approximately 3km and you arrive at Fynbos on Sea

DIRECTIONS FROM PORT ELIZABETH/FROM THE EAST

Take the N2 towards George. Once on the N2 highway, drive approximately 293 km passing the towns of Jeffreys Bay, Plettenberg Bay, Knysna and Sedgefield.

You will pass the Engen One-Stop Garage on your left as you leave the small town of Sedgefield. You drive over the bridge that crosses over the Swartvlei Lake and then turn left at the Sedgelinks/Swartvlei Beach Road.

Drive for only 90 metres and turn right into the Sedgelinks parking area. The entrance gate into Fynbos on Sea is on the right-hand side of the parking area. Follow the paved road up the headland for approximately 3km and you arrive at Fynbos on Sea.
