



FACT SHEET - Selous Game Reserve, Tanzania

TANZANIA MAP



Azura Selous is located on the banks of the Great Ruaha River, in the south of Tanzania. The Selous is known for its private and exclusive game sightings, where there is typically only a single vehicle at any viewing. The camp is surrounded by indigenous vegetation and stunning flora and fauna, the tented villas are spread along the river with magnificent views. The large decked area and infinity pool at the heart of the lodge overlooks the rapids of the Great Ruaha River and resident noisy hippos.

The Selous Game Reserve is one of the largest faunal reserves of the world, some twice the size of South Africa's Kruger National Park, and 3 times the size of the Serengeti National Park. The landscape is generally flat with rolling hills and alluvial valleys with a range of woodland communities, thickets, gallery forests, swamps and alluvial floodplains. It supports vast herds of elephants, buffaloes, giraffe, hippopotamuses, ungulates, crocodiles and other species.







The area surrounding Azura Selous comprises of open grasslands, thickets, forests, ravines, sand rivers, and higher altitude plains, which along with the Great Ruaha River flowing through it, makes for a thrilling and diversified game viewing experience. Azura Selous is particularly known for its predators, being home range for 3 packs of wild dog and some 6 prides of lion.

The climate has warm temperatures year-round with very hot days January to March but also some welcome rain showers. The long dry season is from June to October. Light rains November to December are wonderful and never last for more than an hour. Unlike safaris elsewhere in Africa, you will never have need of a blanket or hot water bottle on the vehicle for our game drives.

Unlike most safari lodges we don't group our guests together for meal times unless you specifically request to eat together. The concept here is that each meal time is a special occasion, it is a relaxed experience and a gourmet one. Guests receive Azura's trademark Tanzanian Host service, where dining experiences are different through a range of unique and special venues and set-ups.

Children aged 6 and above are welcome at Azura Selous, and the wildlife paradise offers numerous possibilities for children and families. Where possible we will endeavour to place families on a private game viewing vehicle. Our guides are specially trained in how to host children, and we offer a range of children's activities including tracking, spore identification, walks within our concession area, general bush craft, and fishing. Our tented villas are very spacious and can easily accommodate 2 extra beds and children sharing with parents stay free of charge.

- Night drives; experience the nocturnal wildlife
- Walking safaris; Follow the tracks, sights, smells and sounds of animals big and small
- Boating safaris on the Ruaha River are a wonderful way to see the African game.

- Fishing; the Great Ruaha is home to many species of fish, including the Electric Catfish, & soughtafter Tiger Fish.

- Pamily safaris: We personalise your stay as a family, providing your own guide and vehicle whenever possible. As well as taking game drives, our guides will offer a variety of educational activities including tracking lessons.

Azura will undertake a number of initiatives at Azura Selous, including steps to further protect the pristine natural and wildlife environment, aided by the eco energy control initiative, and the grey water recycling plant (the only one of its kind in the Selous). ACCESS

The Sumbazi airstrip in the Upper Selous is located 5 minutes from camp. There are several scheduled daily flights connecting from Dar es Salaam, Zanzibar, the Serengeti and other. Dar es Salaam can be accessed from all over the world as it is an international airport.
