

NORTH ISLAND OKAVANGO: FACTS & INFORMATION

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QUINTESSENTIALLY OKAVANGO DELTA, THIS ISLAND CAMP EMBODIES THE ESSENCE OF AN ICONIC DELTA SAFARI EXPERIENCE.

WHERE IS NORTH ISLAND OKAVANGO

18°54'55.87"S and 22°36'49.84"E

As the name denotes, the camp is found on an island (known locally as Xuxuga) surrounded by the diverse habitats of this area – seasonal floodplains, permanent waterways, woodland and open savannah. Being at the upstream end of the Okavango Delta, this area is the first to get the annual floodwaters, opening up waterbased viewing activities.

WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

North Island is open all year round and offers a combination of land, water and air experiences - game drives, boating, mokoro and scenic helicopter flights. **Dry season:** April – October **Green season:** November – March *Please see our rates sheet for detailed information on seasons & pricing.*

HOW DO I GET THERE

Direct flights from Cape Town and Johannesburg to Maun, followed by a light aircraft transfer to Kadizora airstrip for a short onward transfer to camp.

WHERE WILL I STAY

There are only 3 spacious tents (with a fourth coming in March 2024), each resting on raised wooden decks under the shady boughs of wild ebony trees, with stunning views of the lagoon. Each offers 140 square metres of total floor space (including the deck, outside shower and pool), with 80 square metres of interior floor space. Styled by bold shapes, textures and contemporary inspired African design, here you'll enjoy exceptional comfort and luxury. Complete with en-suite bathrooms, indoor and outdoor showers. mini-bar, ceiling-fan, private veranda and pool. Each bed also comes with an 'over-the-bed' cooling system for sleeping comfort. The camp is shaded by a congregation of enormous 30-50 foot trees. To have so many big trees so tightly packed along the water's edge is a very rare occurrence in the Delta where elephant activity usually impacts significantly on their growth.



FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

Airstrip transfers, all meals, daily activities, local drinks and laundry are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature and personal travel insurance are excluded.

WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

Overlooking the hippo-filled lagoon, the separate lounge and dining areas are connected by a deck, which extends outward for stargazing around the fire. Separate library and outdoor gym areas to the side.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- We can accommodate a maximum of 6 adults and 6 children (2 in each suite on a sleeper couch).
- It is 100% solar, with 24-hour electricity in the rooms operating both the Evening Breeze cooling system over the bed and a fan.
- Wi-Fi is only available in the rooms.
- The game drive vehicles are open and will accommodate a maximum of 6 guests (with a private vehicle for extra exclusivity).
- We welcome children 6 yrs and older. Please refer to our rates for child policies.



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WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

- Morning and afternoon game drives.
- Fantastic Delta birding.
- Boating. Subject to water levels. Year-round in good rainfall periods.
- Mokoro excursions all year.
- Fishing: 01 Mar 31 Dec (no fishing permitted Jan Feb due to breeding season).
- Head out by heli on a community visit to meet with some of our community based outreach partners in the nearby villages. You'll also spend time with one of our conservation partners to see first hand how together we are able to make a difference to wildlife conservation in the area.*
