Hwange is known for its diverse wildlife and prolific birdlife. There are over 100 different mammal species in the Park and an estimated 500 bird species.

Summer temperatures average 28°C going up to 35-40°C in the hottest months between December and January.

FACTS & FACILITIES

- The main entertainment area includes a dining, bar and lounge area with an open air fire pit.
- Fully inclusive rate includes all meals & beverages, accommodation, activities, laundry and Emergency Medical Evacuation cover.
- Children are most welcome and should be under the supervision of their parents or a guardian at all times.
- Children aged 12 years and under will be charged 50% of the adult sharing rate. Children aged 13 years and older will be charged full adult rate.
- All children under the age of 14 should be accompanied by one parent or Legal guardian in the room at night.
- The age limit for children on a walking safari is 14 years and above, however, this will be at the discretion of the Pro guide in camp.
- All guests must sign our indemnity form on arrival in camp.
- There are USB charging ports in the game drive vehicles for charging of cameras and electrical items.
- Gratuities and all items of a personal nature are not included in our rates
- Private vehicles can be arranged prior to arrival at an additional charge.
