The camp's remote setting among a thicket of trees surrounded by sweeping grass plains gives Mila an air of seclusion while simultaneously bringing you closer to nature. Boasting close proximity to the Grumeti River and phenomenal year-round wildlife encounters, Mila is ideal for those seeking a classic, tented safari experience.

Location	Mila is located in Nyasirori, a game-rich area in the western region of the Serengeti National Park. In close proximity to Grumeti River.
Access and transfers	 ± 1 hour drive from Grumeti Airstrip to Mila Tented Camp – arrival and departure transfers included. Enquire for longer transfer costs (such as Seronera Airstrip). Fly with Coastal Aviation, Air Excel, Regional Air, or Auric Air for in-seat flights. Private charters available.
Opening dates	Open all year except from 01 Apr – 15 May.


DINING

The long rains are between April and May, and June to mid-August is the dry season. Rains are subject to change. The Great Migration follows the rainfall cycles in search of nutrient-rich grasses.				
Seasonality		Tanzania has something special to showcase in each season. Rainfall and weather changes may cause unexpected adjustments in logistics. Mila has spectacular resident game all year round.
