- NO COLLECTING OF FIREWOOD
- NO FIRES except in braai facilities
- COVER UNATTENDED FIRES

- NO LITTERING
- NO PETS
- NO NOISE, LOUD MUSIC, ETC
- NO FIREWORKS
- NO DRONES
- NO ACCESS TO GREEN BELT between 22:00 & 05:00

Failure to follow these rules will result in action being taken against visitors, this may include fines and/or eviction from the Estate.
