# HOW TO GET TO NALEDI BUSH LODGE:

- From O. R. Tambo International Airport:
- As you exit O. R. Tambo take the R21 (Boksburg) motorway and then the N12 toward the town of eMalahleni (formerly called Witbank).
- As you pass through eMalahleni (Witbank), the N12 will merge into the N4.
- Continue on the N4, travelling past Middelburg.
- Turn off the N4 towards Belfast (R33).
- As you pass through Belfast, follow the signs to Dullstroom (R540).
- Pass through Dullstroom continue to and through Mashishing (formerly called Lydenburg), still on the R540, and continue toward Ohrigstad (R36).
- Proceed through Ohrigstad towards Hoedspruit (R527).
- After Ohrigstad the road starts gradually to wind down the escarpment, taking you from the Highveld to the Lowveld terrain and passes through the Abel Erasmus Tunnel. Continue through to Hoedspruit Town (R527).
- On entering Hoedspruit, at the 3rd four-way stop turn left to Phalaborwa (the R40, also called Klaserie Road).
- Travel 16.5 kilometres on the R40 to reach the "Balule Olifants West Gate" on your right. (Just as the speed limit changes to 80km)
- Turn right into the Reserve gate.
- The gate-guard will ask your destination and call Naledi to notify us of your arrival.
- From here you will receive an envelope with directions to the Lodge.

- Turn right at the sign and proceed to the Lodge where the staff will be awaiting your arrival.
