**HOW TO BOOK:**

Please check availability of the vehicle with your Asilia consultant and book the same way you would a private vehicle

**COST:**

US\$500 per day supplement

**LOCATIONS:**

- Serengeti north: Sayari
- Serengeti central: Namiri Plains
- Masai Mara: Naboisho
- Ruaha: Jabali Ridge and Jabali Private House

**SPECIAL FEATURES:**

- Drop-down sides for photographers to lie down and get low-angle photographs
- Three 360-degree swivel seats, one per “row” — seats also lean right back if required
- Only front and back bars to hold up the roof — less obstruction of view for photography
- Beanbags and foam camera rest — photographers advised to bring their own tripods
- All the usual Asilia vehicle kit — fridge, charging points (UK three-pin plugs), roll down sides for bad weather, etc.

**NEED TO KNOW:**

- Accommodates three photographers, there is no space for any additional guests in the vehicle.
- Not possible to use from a third-party property — must be an Asilia Reserve camp
