Found in the most remote location at Namibia's Skeleton Coast, Pelican Point Lodge truly is a destination on its own. The former harbour control building was elegantly transformed into a boutique hotel, a lodge comprising 10 contemporary and individually decorated Suites, including the unique Captain's Cove, a spacious Penthouse Suite that offers 360 degree views of the Pelican Point Peninsula. A stay at Pelican Point Lodge can be as relaxing and soul-enriching as one likes or be an active and adventurous holiday – and often a bit of both. A myriad of activities are on offer, giving guests the opportunity to experience closeness to nature, the exclusive remoteness of Pelican Point Lodge and various activities reaching across the Pelican Point Peninsula and beyond.

General Terms & Conditions

Acceptance of these rates constitutes acceptance of our Terms and Conditions. We reserve the right to make changes to our Terms and Conditions from time to time.

Payments:

A 20% deposit to secure accommodation is required to confirm any booking, payable within 7 calendar days from date of booking. Full pre-payment is due 60 days prior to arrival. Pelican Point Lodge reserves the right to cancel a booking if full payment has not been received 60 days prior to arrival, resulting in the deposit being forfeited.

Cancellations:

Any confirmed booking that is being cancelled is subject to the following cancellation fees:

Cancellations 60 days prior to arrival date incur a 20% administration fee.

60 - 31 days prior to arrival date: 50%

30 - 8 days prior to arrival date: 75%

7 - 0 days prior to arrival date, no shows and early departure: 100%

The cancellation fee is calculated on the entire length of the stay and the total booking value, including extra's such as pilot/guide accommodation, activities, etc.

Bank Details:

Payment can be made by EFT/bank transfer, proof of payment must be emailed to our office as confirmation of payment. All bank charges are for the account of the booker.

Government Tourism Levy and VAT

A compulsory Government Tourism Levy of 1% of the DBB and FI rate, before VAT, is included in the rate sheets as well as 15% VAT.

Children policy

Much of the charm of Pelican Point Lodge lies in its tranquil wilderness setting and may therefore not always be appreciated by all children. It is a condition therefore that adults accompanying children take full responsibility for the conduct and safety of their children. A maximum of 2 children up to 12 years can be accommodated with their parents in the same room, extra beds will be provided.

- Children up to and including 6 years, sharing the same room with 2 full paying adults, stay for free.
- Children from 7 to 12 years, sharing the same room with 2 full paying adults pay the children rate as stated in the rate overview.

Minimum Stay & Recommended Stay

While we recommend a 2 or even 3 nights stay at Pelican Point Lodge for any time of the year, we have a mandatory 2 night minimum stay for stays between 20 December until 6 January.

Arrival and departure excursions for guests traveling by car

Pelican Point Lodge is situated on the eco-fragile Pelican Point peninsula and is only accessible via a 4x4 vehicle or by boat operated by Pelican Point Lodge. One arrival Nature drive by 4x4 and one departure Dolphin Cruise by boat are offered complimentary, subject to pre-booking.

Transfers are compulsory and vehicles are parked at owner's risk at the Pelican Bay Hotel parking.

If additional transfers between the lodge and Walvis Bay, Swakopmund or Arandis are required, they will be charged for separately.

Arrival excursion: pick-up and check-in times.

Check-in time starts from 14h00. Pick-up point at the Pelican Bay Hotel parking: at 14:00 and 17:00, subject to pre-booking. Pick-up at the Airports of Walvis Bay, Swakopmund or Arandis on ETA of the flight, subject to pre-booking. Supplements for pick-ups at the airports of Swakopmund and Arandis apply as per above rates under 'other extras'.

Departure excursion: checkout and departure times.

Checkout time is at 08:00 to allow for the complimentary departure Dolphin Cruise leaving in time.

Departure is at 08:30 with the boat for the complimentary Dolphin cruise ending at the Waterfront in Walvis Bay around 10h30. In the event that weather, force majeure or any operational circumstances beyond our control, would not permit to go out by boat, then guests will be offered a departure excursion by 4x4. Fly-in guests are taken to the airport of departure after the Dolphin cruise. If the ETD of the departure flight of fly-in guests is not compatible with the time of arrival of our boat then guests will be taken by 4x4 to the Airport. Supplements for drop-offs at the airports of Swakopmund and Arandis apply as per above rates under 'other extras'.

Carbon Footprint:

Pelican Point Lodge is situated on the eco-fragile Peninsula in the Dorob National park and right in the middle of the ocean. We bear conservation very close to our heart and part of our mission statement is to keep our eco-footprint as small as possible without compromising the comfort of our guests. As a standard we switch on the generator from 18h00 till 22h00 in the evening and from 06h00 till 09h00 in the morning, we also keep the generator running while our guests are enjoying themselves in the lounge and restaurant after 22h00. During the times that the generator is off, we run water on gravitational feed. For guests bringing their respiration support equipment, we are happy to provide batteries but will need to be informed upon booking. Should we not have been informed beforehand and no batteries are available, we will run the generator at extra charge for the guest. It goes without saying that we prefer not to start the generator for charging electronic devices such as mobile phones, tablets or batteries guests may have forgotten to charge during our standard generator running times. Furthermore, we use bio fires in the lounge and restaurant as well as in the guest accommodation.

Travel Insurance

Pelican Point Lodge recommends that guests take out comprehensive travel insurance to cover them for personal accident, medical and emergency travel expenses as well as cancellation of the booking.
