





Remotely nestled away on a huge private concession in the northern part of Hwange National Park, Nehimba Lodge combines comfort, elegance and African charm to provide you with an exceptional safari experience. Our nine spacious canvas under thatch tents are built on teak decks along with the guest area, overlooking the magnificent lodge pan, which is frequented by large numbers of elephants, particularly in the dry season.




## LOCATION

- Nehimba Private Concession, Hwange National Park, Matabeleland North Province, Zimbabwe.
- 1 hour small plane charter from Victoria Falls to Hwange Main Airport followed by a 2-2.5 hour drive into camp.
- 1 hour small plane charter from Victoria Falls to Giraffe Springs Airstrip followed by a 20 minute drive into camp (Giraffe Springs is seasonal).
- Distances by road: Victoria Falls Mbala Gate 130 km, and 95 km through the Park. Victoria Falls – Main Camp 185 km, and 60 km through the Park (4x4 is not necessary). Bulawayo - Main Camp 285 km, and 60 km through the Park. Bulawayo – Mbala Gate 370 km, and 95 km through the Park (4x4 is not necessary).
- Giraffe Springs Airstrip South 18 52 05.49 / East 026 35 18.3
- Lodge co-ordinates South 18 52 27.76 / East 026 29 03.02

# ACCOMMODATION

- 2 x family rooms: 60 m sq with thatched roof overlooking the watering hole, 1 king sized bed and 2 x ¾ beds, fan, tea and coffee making facilities, electronic safes, en suite bathroom and outdoor shower.
- **1 x double room with day bed:** 60 m sq with thatched roof overlooking the watering hole, king sized bed, fan, tea and



coffee making facilities, electronic safe, en suite bathroom and outdoor shower.

- 3 x double rooms: 57.75 m sq with thatched roof overlooking the lodge waterhole, king sized beds, fan, tea and coffee making facilities, electronic safes, en suite bathroom and outdoor shower.
- **1 x double room:** 42 m sq with thatched roof overlooking the lodge waterhole, king sized bed, fan, tea and coffee making facilities, electronic safe, en-suite bathroom and outdoor shower.
- 2 x twin room: 57.75 m sq with thatched roof overlooking the lodge waterhole, 2 x ¾ beds, fan, tea and coffee making facilities, electronic safe, en-suite bathroom and outdoor shower.

### FACILITIES

- Guest area comprising open fronted thatched building, bar area, lounge and dining room overlooking the lodge waterhole.
- Free WiFi in the main lodge area .
- Splash Pool (Seasonal)
- Electricity by solar.

### **ACTIVITIES**

Hwange National Park at 14,500 sq km, is one of Africa's great Parks and is home to over 100 species of mammals, including nineteen large herbivore and eight large carnivore species, and nearly 400 species of birds. Hwange is elephant country and much of the game viewing relates to magnificent opportunities to view these, the largest land mammals, in a completely wild state. The lodge estate is an exclusive 43 500 acre portion of northern Hwange National Park.

## AT THE LODGE

- Nehimba is situated on its own private estate within the National Park and wild animals including lion, leopard, buffalo and hyena wander freely through the area.
- Enjoy a steaming cup of coffee on your private balcony at dawn or whittle away the last of the daylight hours on the guest area deck with sundowners, observing the many different animals that pass in front of the lodge and quench their thirst at the waterhole.

#### **GAME DRIVES**

- Morning and afternoon game drives with snacks in traditional open safari vehicles.
- All day game drives with a packed lunch and snacks in traditional open safari vehicles.
- Land Cruisers seat up to 9 guests and Land Rovers seat up to 7 guests.

#### **GAME WALKS**

- Conducted by an experienced and knowledge guide.
- Usually undertaken in the mornings and ideal for photography of big game on foot.

#### **NIGHT DRIVES**

- For those who would like to view Hwange in an entirely different 'light', we offer our guests the opportunity to accompany one of our guides on a night drive within our concession.
- Filtered spotlights are used to pick out the various nocturnal species that can be found such as hyena, porcupine, civet, genet cat, and if you're lucky, perhaps even a leopard on a hunt!

#### **VISIT THE NEHIMBA SEEPS**

- This is a specially designated conservation area and is one of the few year-round, naturally occurring sources of sur face water in the massive Hwange National Park.
- The seep is an ancient source of water that was once used by the San bushmen. Today elephant visit the seep to dig for minerals and water.

### **VISIT MANDAVU DAM**

- Situated in a scenic and hilly area 15 km from Sinamatella Camp, this dam is a wonderful spot for bird watching and game viewing.
- Take a leisurely drive to the dam in the morning and enjoy a picnic brunch on the dam's edge, all the while enjoying the variety of life that visits this picturesque spot.

### **RATES INCLUDE**

### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

- 30 days + before travel = 75% refund .
- 16 29 days before travel = 50% refund.
- 8 15 days before travel = 25% refund.
- 0 7 days before travel or non arrivals = no refund.

## **CHILDREN**

- Children under the age of 7 are only allowed by special arrangement subject to restrictions, particularly to do with private dining options and a separate vehicle for game drives and is at the sole discretion of lodge management.
- Children aged 12 and below pay 50% on accommodation portion only and must share with an adult.
- Up to 2 children may share a tent with an adult.
