

## WHY CHOOSE HWANGE NATIONAL PARK?



- With 14 651 square kilometers of wilderness to explore, Hwange National Park is bigger than the Serengeti National Park.
- Hwange has about 43 000 visitors per year, a density of 3 people per km<sup>2</sup> per year. Compare it to Serengeti with 23 people per km<sup>2</sup> per year, Kruger with 85, and Masai Mara with 192. It's possible you will spend most of your safari without seeing other vehicles except those from the lodge you are staying at making it a very exclusive experience!
- Hwange National Park is easy to reach from Victoria Falls by air in a private charter or a combination of road and rail transfer.
- Hwange is home to approximately 46 000 elephants, compared with Masai Mara at 3 700, Kruger at 13 750 and Serengeti at 2 100. In the dry season in Hwange it is likely you will see elephants numbering in the hundreds congregating at water points. Amazingly there are more elephants than guests visiting Hwange National Park in a year!
- Hwange National Park offers exceptional game viewing year round and can compete with the best parks in Africa for diversity of wildlife and within Zimbabwean parks, the largest species diversity and populations of sable, cheetah, wild dog and lion.
- Hwange's Professional Guides serve apprenticeships lasting between 5 and 10 years and their skills are recognized as among the best in Africa. Your Professional Guide will take you on a walks inside the park, showing you how to approach game on foot, read animal tracks, and learn the intimacies of the ecosystem around you, all adding to a wonderful safari experience for our guests.
- Your Safari Lodge or Camp in Hwange National Park is small and personal – 8 rooms serving 16 guests is a typical size – there's only one hotel with close to 100 beds outside the national park.
