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Activities on offer at Moon Mountain Lodge - 2024

Sossuvlei Excursion – N\$2 400.00 pp

Sesriem, the gateway to Sesriem Canyon, Sossuvlei and Deadvlei, all within the Namib Naukluft Park, situated 60 km south of Moon Mountain Lodge. Driving time is just under an hour to the entrance. Adventurist guests who prefer to explore the attractions by themselves, may do so in their own 4x4 vehicle. Moon Mountain Lodge does offer guests the option to join their guided Sossuvlei excursion in the comfort of a lodge vehicle.

The Sossuvlei activity includes, the entrance permits, onboard refreshments and a picnic brunch.

Pre-bookings are essential, since the lodge vehicles can only take up to 15 persons at a time.

Vehicles and guides are pending availability and are not guaranteed when persons book last minute.

Departure time from the lodge is just before sunrise. Warm beverages and rusks are served at the main area before departure.

Return time from Sossusvlei may vary, depending on the heat of the day but, usually guests are back at the lodge by 15h00.



Mountain Sunset Excursion – N\$680.00 pp

The activity departs the lodge 1 hour before sunset.

During winter, from May to August the sun sets earlier. It is thus necessary to check-in by no later than 15h30. By 17h00 the activity will depart if you plan to participate.

During the summer months the activity starts later. Best check-in time is by 16h00 to settle in and at +/- 17h30 the activity will depart.

The drive will be conducted on the property with the possibility to see desert antelope such as Oryx, wildebeest, springbok, red-hartebeest, steenbok, and a few elusive mountain zebra, ostrich, and smaller birds. Undeniably, the most spectacular is the Pro-Namib landscape and surrounding mountains that never fail to impress. Enjoy your African sunset with cold alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverages and a platter of snacks from an elevated vantage point overlooking the stunning scenery. After sunset, you will be transferred back to the lodge to freshen up and enjoy a sumptuous three-course dinner.

Self-Guided Hiking Trail – No charge

The trail is +/- 8 kilometers long. The best time to walk the trail is early morning or later afternoon when the sun is not so intense. You can determine your own pace while enjoying the scenery and plains game dotting the landscape. Take a bottle of water along with your walking stick and binoculars, you are guaranteed to experience something uniqueness of what the Namib holds for you.
