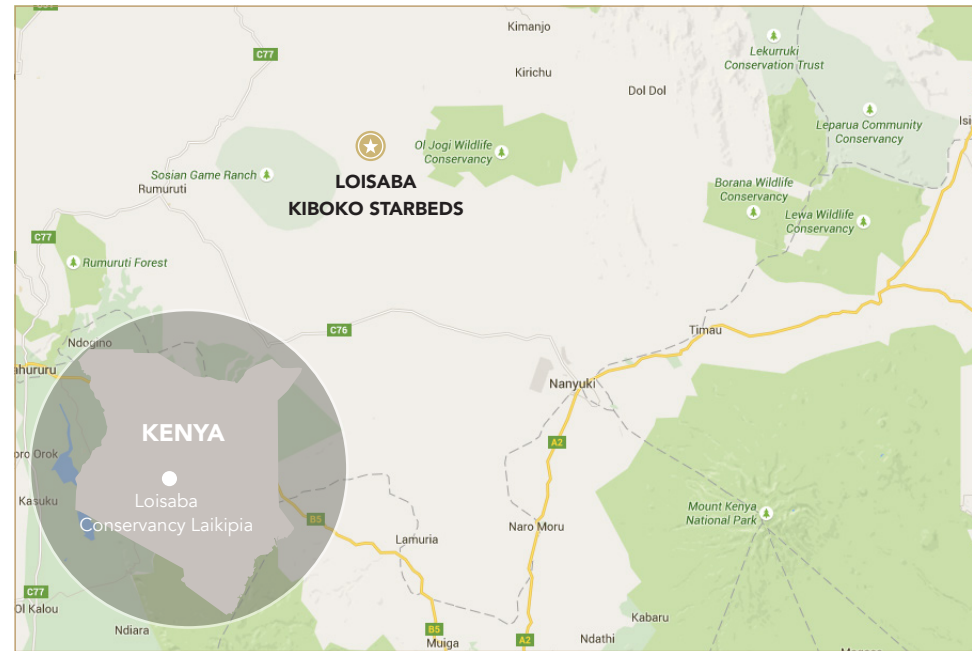




KIBOKO STARBEDS

LOCATION

The Kiboko Starbeds are situated on a hillside overlooking the Kiboko waterhole, a busy wildlife focal point with resident hippo. Loisaba is a 56,000 acre private wildlife conservancy famous for its elephant population, as well as the big cats, and is one of the best locations to see Wild Dog. "Loisaba" is the Samburu name for the Seven Sisters constellation.

HOW TO GET THERE

Loisaba Airstrip is a 30 minute drive from the Kiboko Starbeds.

- Twice daily scheduled Safarilink flight departing Nairobi Wilson at 08h00 & 10h20, min 2 pax.
- Twice daily scheduled Safarilink flight to Nanyuki departing Nairobi Wilson at 08h00 and 10h20 to connect with private charter.
- In high season extra Safarilink flight departing Nairobi Wilson at 13h00, min 2 pax.
- Once daily scheduled Air Kenya flight to Nanyuki departing Nairobi Wilson at 09h15 to connect with private charter.
- Private air charters from anywhere.
- Road transfers from Nanyuki airstrip, approx. 4hrs.
- Road directions available on request.

ACCOMMODATION & FACILITIES

"Starbeds" are ensuite rooms on raised open wooden platforms, with a rollout bed open to the stars.

- 3 ensuite rooms with double beds
- 1 ensuite family room with two double beds rolled onto separate outside platforms.
- Dining room, lounge area and open decked verandah

- Dining times are as follows:
Breakfast: 06h30 to 09h30
Lunch: 13h00 to 14h30
Dinner: 20h00 to 21h30

Individual dietary requests can be satisfied with advance notice.

- Shared dining in dining room lounge. Private dining available.
