

HONEY BEAR FACT FILE

Description

Honey Bear Bush Camp is named after Ava Gardner's character in the 1950's Oscar winning film Mogambo. Our Camp evokes the same spirit of her character: Elegant, classy and sassy with a propensity for adventure. Under canvas in the classic safari style, with an intimate 5 tents. Each of the tents faces the famous Kazinga channel, where you can watch elephant frolic and hippos honking all day long from the comfort of your bed.

LOCATION

Located within Queen Elizabeth National Park in the Kyambura Game Reserve, Honey Bear Bush camp is on the southern bank of the Kazinga Channel about 8 km from Katunguru Village and about 3 km from the Kyambura Gorge.

FACILITIES

Accommodation

Honey Bear consists of 5 Luxury en-suite tents (36 sqm). They contain King-size beds that can be arranged as a Double, Twin, or Single.

Each ensuite bathroom has running water, flush toilets and feature and outdoor 'safari style' bush shower. Butler service is available for guests along with a communal dining area.

Mess Tent

A spacious, breezy mess tent with comfortable sofas and inviting sitting areas. There is a bar area, communal dining table for family style dining, and a fire pit on the lawn. Guests are advised to pack slip-on shoes/flip-flops as all the tents, including the Mess, are no-shoe tents.

Views

Each tent, including the mess has open views of the Kazinga channel, where hippos roam and elephants come to drink and swim.

HONEY BEAR BUSHCAMP IS OPEN THROUGHOUT THE YEAR AND HAS THE FOLLOWING SEASONS:

Green Season: April, May & October, November — Moderate Temperatures, need of rain gear such as rain jackets. Lush green vegetation and more dispersed wildlife. Exceptional views of the stunning Rwenzori Mountains.

Dry Season: January, February, March, June, July, August, September, December

Hot and dry, animals are more likely to gather by the channel, especially elephants.

FAUNA & FLORA

Birds: Exceptional birding with many Water & Savanna birds (e.g. pelicans, kingfishers, fish eagles, storks bee-eaters, Egyptian geese, African jacana, various owls, various hornbill, coucals and many others.)

Mammals: The two bays by the camp have the highest density of hippos in the National Park. Elephants, Waterbuck, Warthog, Buffaloes, Giant Forest Hogs, and Ugandan Kob are common. Lion, Leopard & Hyena have been spotted near camp. Chimpanzees can be found in the Kyambura Gorge just around the corner.

Reptiles: Crocodiles, monitor lizards, Terrapins and more.

CHILDREN: No guests below the age of 15 years old will be accommodated at the property.

ACCESS

Access is currently best by our included boat transfer from Katunguru or our Kasenyi boat launch. Guests can also access the camp by road.

By air, domestic flights land at either Kasese Airstrip or Mweya Airstrip. Both airstrips are an hour's drive from the hoat launch.
