







Located in the northwest region of Laikipia in central Kenya, forming part of over 80,937 hectares (200,000 acres) of privately managed land, Suyian Conservancy shelters a diverse array of ecosystems and rich wildlife, offering an immersive safari experience.

Why visit Suyian Conservancy?

A wildlife-rich and diverse ecosystem nestled between the southeast and northwest Laikipia Conservancies, with the Ewaso Narok River in the east and the snow-capped silhouette of Mt Kenya as its backdrop.

EXCLUSIVE LOCATION

Suyian shelters approximately 17 806 hectares (44 000 acres) of prime wilderness and conservation land with private traversing rights across five distinct habitats.

The conservancy forms part of a vital wildlife movement corridor between Laikipia and the northern conservancies. A limited number of vehicles and sensitive off-roading practices afford close-up sightings of iconic wildlife.

A WILDLIFE HAVEN

The Laikipia region is home to many of the country's endangered species, with rarities including the elusive black (melanistic) leopard. It's also seen successful growth of African wild dog populations and is now recognised as the second most important site for them in Africa. You're also likely to encounter large numbers of unique Grevy's zebra, gerenuk, and reticulated giraffe.

CONSERVATION AT HEART

Once a family-owned cattle ranch dating back to 1920, over time the conservancy has been transformed from purely a livestock area to one managed for land preservation and community development. Today, wildlife moves freely between neighbouring conservancies and Suyian, which together host a larger concentration of wildlife than any other protected or unprotected landscape in Kenya, outside of the Masai Mara National Reserve.

GETTING THERE

To and around Kenya


Nairobi is the main airport for international flights from South Africa, the United Kingdom, France, Netherlands and Dubai. From Nairobi, there are scheduled daily flights from Wilson Airport into Laikipia, Mombasa, Lamu, Amboseli, Masai Mara, Meru, Nanyuki and Samburu. Charter flights are also available and fly directly to either of the coastal airports of Mombasa or Malindi.

To &Beyond Suyian Conservancy

The conservancy is easily accessible by air and road.

Both Safarilink and Air Kenya offer scheduled twicedaily flights by light aircraft from Nairobi's Wilson Airport to Loisaba Airstrip in Laikipia, followed by a 1-hour vehicle transfer to Suyian Conservancy. Private flight charters directly into Suyian's private airstrip are also available.

Laikipia is accessible by road from Nairobi (an approximate 5-hour drive) and Nanyuki (an approximate 1 and a half hour drive) in a 4x4 vehicle. Road transfer times depend on traffic.

Best time to travel	Laikipia is a fantastic year-round destination. The long, cool dry season occurs from July to October, and the short, hot dry season occurs in January and February. During these times, water is limited, so wildlife is easily found gathered near or around the last remaining sources. The conservancies in Laikipia have many wetlands that attract yet disperse an abundance of animals during the short rains in November and December, as well as the long rains from April to June.	
Weather	The climate at Laikipia Plateau is cool and temperate. Temperatures are uniform throughout the year due to being so close to the equator.	
Rainfall	Laikipia is a semi-arid area. The long, cool dry season occurs from July to October, and the short, hot dry season occurs in January and February. The long rains typically occur from April to June and the short rains in November and December.	
Temperature averages	June to September: Temperatures don't vary too much and are around 24°C (75°F). It can be cold at night and in the early morning, with a temperature of around 12°C (54°F).	
	October to May: Temperatures range from 12°C (54°F) - 24°C (75°F), rain dependent.

TWICE-DAILY GAME DRIVES

Suyian is not only home to some of Africa's most iconic species, but also presents the opportunity to encounter rarely seen and unique Laikipia wildlife 'specials', such as the Beisa oryx, striped hyena, Laikipia hartebeest, desert warthog and black (melanistic) leopard. Enjoy exclusive twice-daily game drives during which our renowned &Beyond guides will interpret their life stories, providing guests with an intimate insight into the region.

GUIDED BUSH WALKS

Hop off the safari vehicle and explore the Suyian Conservancy on foot, accompanied by your expert guide. This is an opportunity to truly get to know the remarkable sights and sounds of Suyian. Discover some of the oftenoverlooked smaller creatures found in the conservancy, animal tracks and endemic plant species or simply take in the incredible view atop a rocky outcrop in the hopes of spotting a Verreaux eagle or fan-tailed raven.

PICNIC AND SWIM BY THE RIVER

CATCH-AND-RELEASE FISHING

Indulge in the thrill of catch-and-release fishing along the Ewaso Narok River or cast your line at the numerous waterholes scattered around the conservancy. For the truly intrepid, an expedition to the legendary Lake Turkana awaits, promising an unforgettable angling adventure.

HELICOPTER FLIGHTS*

Not only does a scenic helicopter flight provide aerial views of the region's most diverse landscapes, such as Suguta Valley, Ololokwe and Mt Kenya, but also offers access to some otherwise inaccessible hidden gems that are both ecologically and culturally significant.



ACTIVE RANCHING

What was once an area of huge livestock ranches, today Suyian combines rapidly evolving conservation practices with community development creating a safe space for people and wildlife to coexist. Spend the morning with the local herders as they start their day walking their cattle on the rotational grazing rounds. There are approximately 2 500 to 3 000 cattle that form part of this unique biodiverse ecosystem.



LOCAL COMMUNITY VILLAGE VISITS

Community village visits and interactions with local pastoral tribes, such as the Pokot and Samburu people, add to the conservancy's unique offering, allowing you to become part of a cultural experience that has remained unchanged for thousands of years.




