## Driving Directions to Mahali Mzuri



If you are driving to Mahali Mzuri from Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport you should allow for a journey of 245 kilometres and about 5 hours. If you have a GPS device the coordinates for the camp are: 1° 16' 24.26" S / 35° 13' 22.87" E. Before you set off please contact us with a mobile phone number we can use to reach you and your expected time of arrival. If you get stuck please give us a call on +254 20 5100 090 and we'll do our best to guide you in!

### Directions:

- Leave the airport and follow the A109 (this becomes the A104) out of Nairobi and looking for the junction with the B3 after about 50 kilometres
- Join the B3 heading north – this road swings to the left to take you towards the west after another 20 kilometres
- Continue on the B3 for another 90km until you reach Narok. Keep going on the B3 until you reach the turn off for Ngorengore (about 33km) and turn left
- Join the Murrum Road and continue for 47 kilometres until you reach Aitong Junction at which point turn left
- Follow this road for approximately 8km past the Aitong Primary School on the right until you see the turning for Mahali Mzuri and the Olare Motorogi Conservancy
- You're now on the final stage of the journey to Mahali Mzuri – just another 7-8 km to your destination. We'll have the champagne on ice!
