Songa Migrational Camp

MASWA KIMALI, SOUTHERN SERENGETI

Songa Migrational Camp follows in the path of the Great Migration, locating twice yearly between the northern and southern Serengeti. Guests are granted a front row seat to the procession of more than two million wildebeest, zebra and Thomson's gazelle as they traverse across the vast grass plains.

In its southern location, Songa is situated within Maswa Game Reserve, an exclusive-use wildlife protected area bordering the southern Serengeti. The camp's prime positioning offers guests exclusive access to the vast wildebeest during the calving season — without any other tourists around.




DINING
