

## Songa Migrational Camp

### MASWA KIMALI, SOUTHERN SERENGETI

Songa Migrational Camp follows in the path of the Great Migration, locating twice yearly between the northern and southern Serengeti. Guests are granted a front row seat to the procession of more than two million wildebeest, zebra and Thomson’s gazelle as they traverse across the vast grass plains.

In its southern location, Songa is situated within Maswa Game Reserve, an exclusive-use wildlife protected area bordering the southern Serengeti. The camp's prime positioning offers guests exclusive access to the vast wildebeest during the calving season – without any other tourists around.

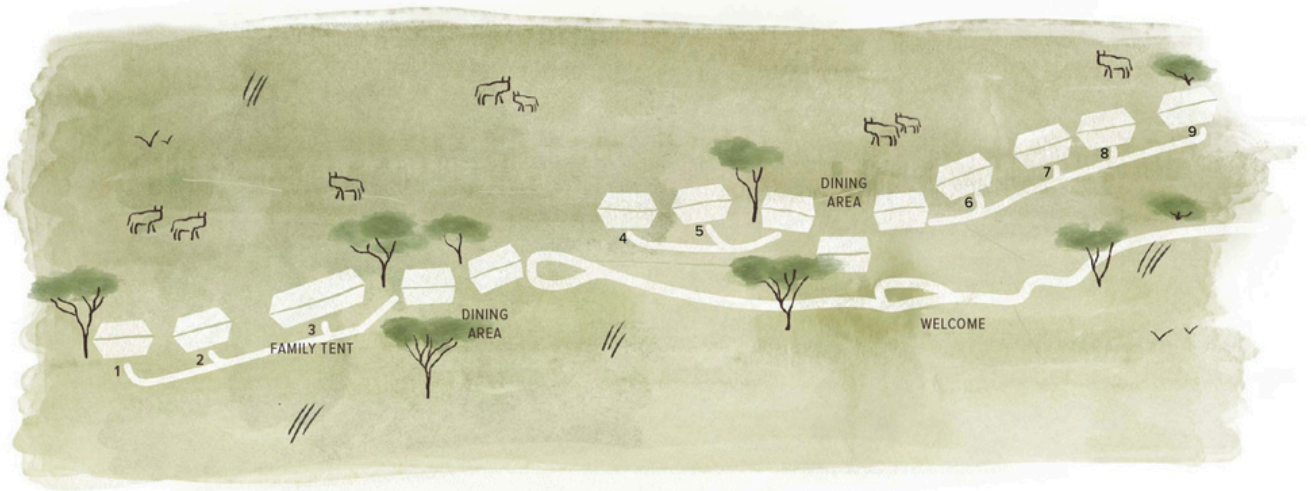
<b>LOCATION &amp; ACCESS</b>	
<b>Location</b>	Songa Migrational Camp South is located in Maswa Game Reserve, an exclusive-use wildlife protected area adjoining the southern Serengeti.
<b>Access &amp; transfers</b>	Maswa Game Reserve: ± 1 hour drive from Mwiba Airstrip (transfers included).
<b>Opening dates</b>	Open from 15 December 2024 to 31 March 2025, and 15 December 2025 to 31 March 2026.

<b>TENTED ROOM FACILITIES</b>		
<b>Bed configuration</b>	King / twin	King (200x180cm) or twin (200x90cm) configuration available.
<b>Extra beds</b>	4	Triple rooming upon availability and prior booking required. Max 4 additional stretcher beds available in camp. A stretcher bed can be arranged for children up to 15 years.
<b>Air conditioning</b>	No	Not available due to power supply capacity.
<b>Fans</b>	Yes	Available in each tented room.
<b>Mosquito nets &amp; repellent</b>	Yes	Mosquito netting and repellent available in each tented room.
<b>En-suite bathroom</b>	Yes	Each tented room has an en-suite bathroom with a fully plumbed indoor shower and a flushing toilet.
<b>Vanity</b>	Double	There are two vanities per tented room.
<b>Bath</b>	No	Not available due to water supply capacity.
<b>Mini-bar</b>	No	Drinks on request.
<b>Safe</b>	No	Personal safe in each tented room.
<b>Telephone</b>	Yes	Satellite phone available upon request at additional charge. Intra-camp dialing not available.

<b>Laundry</b>	Yes	Laundry service included.

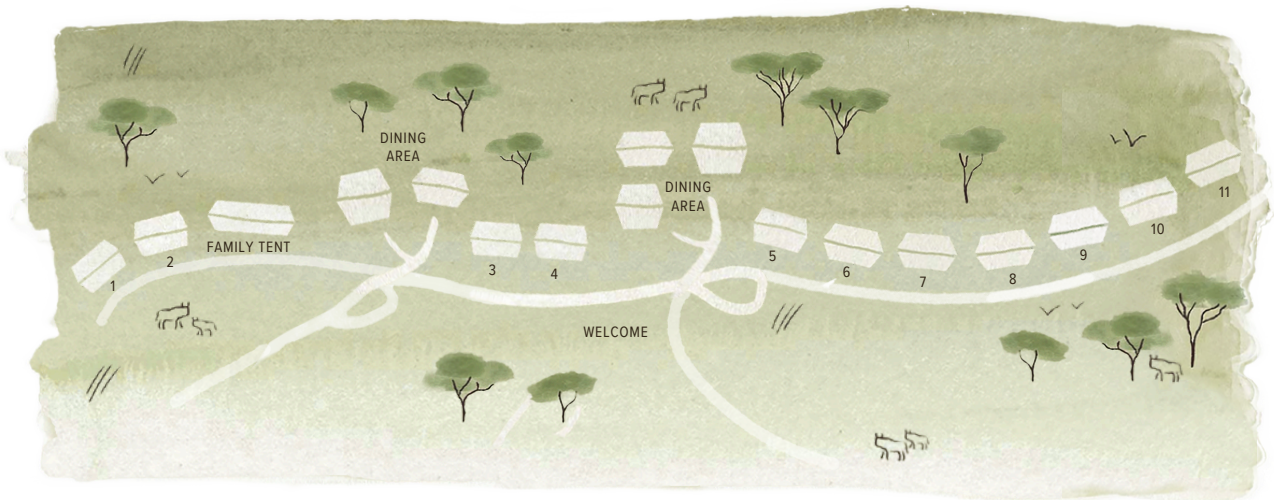
<b>ACTIVITIES</b>		
<b>Private vehicle</b>	Yes	Open Land Cruiser safari vehicles, accompanied by a private guide.
<b>Game drives (day)</b>	Yes	Private game drives accompanied by a private guide.
<b>Game drives (night)</b>	Yes	Available within Songa's southern location in Maswa Game Reserve.
<b>All day safaris</b>	Yes	Full day safaris available.
<b>Walking safaris</b>	Yes	Available within Songa's southern location in Maswa Game Reserve.
<b>Children on safaris</b>	Yes	At the discretion of parents and guides.
<b>Authentic cultural experiences</b>	Yes	Visit the Datoga village.
<b>Off-roading</b>	Yes	Available in Songa's southern location in Maswa Game Reserve, following Tanzanian official regulations and upon discretion of the private guide (weather dependent).
<b>Hot-air ballooning</b>	No	Not available in Songa's southern location in Maswa Game Reserve.
<b>Helicopter Adventures</b>	Yes	Available in Songa's southern location in Maswa Game Reserve. Enquire for journey options and rates. Booking prior to arrival is essential.

<b>Breakfast</b>	Fresh fruits, cereals, yoghurt and pastries as well as hot breakfast.
<b>Lunch &amp; dinner</b>	Lunch and dinner are served 'family-style' sharing per table.
<b>Al-fresco dining</b>	Enjoy breakfast, lunch, dinner or a sundowner amidst the al fresco dining areas within camp (weather dependent).
<b>Bush picnics</b>	Breakfast or lunch can be packed in hampers for full day activities.
<b>Hot box / sundowner box</b>	Hot box: tea, coffee, milk and snacks for morning drives. Sundowner box: soft drinks, preferred alcoholic beverages and snacks for afternoon drives.

NOTE: Songa Migrational Camp South is pitched as a split camp where one side of camp (2 tents and the family tent) has the option to be a 'private camp'. Both sides of camp share a central back of house; however each side operates independently, faces different directions, is fully contained with its own lounge and dining facility, and uses the natural habitat to ensure maximum privacy.

## TRAVEL INFORMATION

### Weather

Warm temperate climate year-round. Can be cooler during the early mornings and late evenings in winter.

### Rainfall

The short rains are usually for Songa South are usually from mid December to mid February with a wonderful, temperate climate from December to March. The long rains are between April and May, and June to mid November is the dry season. Rains are subject to change.

### Seasonality

Tanzania has something special to showcase in each season. Rainfall and weather changes may cause unexpected adjustments in logistics. The Great Migration follows the rainfall cycles and nutritious emerald grasslands.

Highly recommended for guests to obtain a medical insurance prior to arrival, with a policy cover inclusive of emergency airlift evacuation.

### Currency

Tanzanian Shillings, United States Dollar (USD notes must be printed from 2006 onwards and not have any marks on them). Credit card machine available.

### Travel Visa

Visas are required for most countries. Please ensure to review visa arrangements, requirements and e-services prior to arrival through Tanzania Immigration Department online.

### Drones

Are prohibited unless a special permit is obtained prior to arrival to the country.
