CAPACITY

Enasoit Camp can accommodate 16 guests in 8 tented cottages. Extra beds for children can be provided. There are also 2 thatched rooms at the Pool House, which can be used as additional accommodation for larger groups.

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT

Check-in time is 11:00 am onwards. Early check-in can be accommodated on request subject to availability. All guests are required to complete a disclaimer form prior to check in. Check-out time is 10:00 am. Late checkout can be accommodated on request subject to availability.

CHILD RATES

Child rates apply to those aged 5 to 15 years inclusive. Those aged 16 years and above are charged the adult rate. Children 4 years and under stay free of charge. Extra beds for children can be arranged on request.

VISAS

Guests are advised to check visa requirements and make the necessary arrangements before they travel.

ACCESS

Enasoit Camp is located in the Laikipia highlands of Kenya approximately 1 hour flight or 4 hours drive from Nairobi. Private charters into Enasoit's private airstrip (5 minutes drive from Enasoit Camp) are available from anywhere in Kenya, and there are daily scheduled flights from Nairobi into Nanyuki Airstrip (1 hour road transfer to Enasoit).

MEDICAL

Guests should seek professional medical advice before travelling including advice regarding prophylactics, recommended vaccinations and the relevant travel and medical insurance. Flying Doctor Emergency Evacuation Cover is required for all guests and can be arranged on request for \$15 per guest.

TRAVEL AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

All guests are required to have comprehensive travel and medical insurance to cover cancellation, medical expenses, personal baggage and money. The agent hereby agrees to indemnify the properties from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur arising out of failure by the agent to inform the guests of the need to obtain travel insurance.

FLIGHTS AND TRANSFERS

For internal flights within Kenya guests are advised to pack in soft bags with a maximum of 15kg per person (chartered flights may specify otherwise). Transfers to additional destinations can be arranged and vary in price and duration depending on the length of the journey and the condition of the access roads.

TIPPING CULTURE

Gratuities are welcomed and greatly appreciated; please speak to the lodge managers for advice and procedures.

BOOKING PROCEDURES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS



These are the Terms and Conditions that are accepted when booking with The Enasoit Collection (Enosit Ranch Ltd.). By confirming your booking with a deposit you are entering into a contract with The Enasoit Collection and thereby agree to abide by our Terms and Conditions as outlined below.

RESERVATIONS AND CONFIRMATION

Provisional bookings will be held on request for 7 days. If the booking is not confirmed before the expiry date it will automatically expire. If you require more time to confirm your booking, the expiry date may be extended upon request and subject to availability.

Bookings are confirmed upon receipt of a 25% non-refundable deposit.

GUEST INFORMATION

Please ensure that the booking voucher contains the following information:

- Date, time and method of guests arrival and departure
- Number of people in the group & rooming requirements(doubles, singles, triples)
- Names and ages of all guests
- Any special dietary requirements
- Medical conditions that may affect their visit or other special requests

PAYMENT

The balance of payment is payable in full 60 days prior to arrival. On receipt of full payment a final reservation summary will be issued.

PRICE VARIATIONS

In the event of increase in taxes, training levy or service charges, The Enasoit Collection reserves the right to adjust all rates accordingly from the date of such change and without prior notice.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations are only effective on receipt of written notification. Cancellations between 60-31 days 50% of the full payment will be forfeited and 50% will be refunded. Cancellations within 30 days of arrival, 100% cancellation fee will apply.

REFUNDS

The Enasoit Collection has the right at any time and at their discretion to cancel or make alterations to any accommodation or excursion that poses a risk due to weather, political unrest, or any other cause. Any extra expense arising out of the cancellation or alteration of accommodation or excursion will fall to the guests and / or their agents.

PRIVACY POLICY

While the Enasoit Collection is intent on keeping all personal information from the agents confidential, we do share limited information when required to do so by third party suppliers including private charter companies and medical insurance companies. The Enasoit Collection is not liable for any loss of damage arising from third parties' unauthorised access to this information.

TRAVEL ADVISORIES

It is the responsibility of agents and guests to research their country's travel advisories for Kenya, and it is at the complete discretion of the agent or guests to make a booking based on applicable travel advisories for the areas of intended travel.

WILDLIFE

Please be aware that guests may come into close contact with wild animals on safari. Enasoit Camp is an unfenced property on a wildlife conservancy, and whilst dangerous incidents are rare, no safari into the African wilderness can guarantee that this will not occur. Guests are advised to always maintain a safe distance from wildlife and not to walk anywhere unaccompanied. By coming on safari to Enasoit, agents and guests agree to adhere to the above. Neither Enasoit Camp (Enosit Ranch Ltd), nor its employees, nor its agents can be held responsible for any injury or incident.

LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

The Enasoit Collection and its owners, directors, management and employees shall not be held liable for any loss or damage whatsoever to personal property, or any claims or demands from guests on account of injury, illness or death to persons visiting the property, whether caused by negligence or otherwise. This agreement is made subject to and shall be governed and construed according to the laws of Kenya.

DISPUTES

All concerns must be brought to the attention of The Enasoit Collection prior to the guest's departure in order to finalise the issues on the ground at the time. Should this not be possible then they are to be followed up in writing no later than 14 days after departure where the Kenyan legal system will be adhered to exclusively.
