- Hiking & Running
 - In Constantia’s green belt there are no fewer than nine interwoven trails that provide inner-city walking at it’s best. They are easily accessible yet make you feel far away from the city by surrounding you with the green leafiness of Constantia. The Alphen Trail, The Diep River Trail, Spaanschemat River Trail, Grootboschkloof Trail, The Silverhurst Trail, Brommersvlei Walk, Doordrift Walk and Klaasenbosch Trail are some of the trails that are sign posted in the area.  - Weekly evening food market at The Range Function and Conference Centre in Tokai. Fridays 4.30pm - 9.30pm.

SHOPPING

- Constantia Village Shopping Centre
 - The Constantia Village in Constantia offers the convenience of a shopping mall, the quality and desirability of a boutique and the ambience of a village square.  - Family friendly event for the whole community. Selected Fridays (once a term) 5pm - 9pm in Bergvliet.


- Constantia Waldorf Organic Market (Constantia)
 - Weekly organic market at Constantia Waldorf School. Fridays 11am - 3pm. Closed on public holidays and during school holidays.

- Constantia Waldorf Night Market (Constantia)
 - Monthly night market held at the Constantia Waldorf School. Last Friday of the month in Summer. 5pm-9pm. No market in December and closed in winter.

- Alphen Antiques and Collectables Market (Constantia)
 - Bi-monthly antiques and collectables market held at Alphen Community Centre Hall, Constantia. Generally 2nd and 4th Sunday of every month (festive season dates may vary.) 10am - 4pm.

- Vegan Goods Market
 - The Vegan Goods Market is a monthly market focused on ethical, plant-based food. First Saturday of the month at 8 Brent Road, Plumstead (All Saints Church) 10am - 2pm.
