EXPLORE THE HEIGHTS OF MARIEPSKOP:

A Natural Wonder in the Northern Drakensberg. Mariepskop, soaring at an elevation of 1,945 meters above sea level, stands proudly as one of the northern Drakensberg's loftiest peaks and holds the distinction of being the highest point within the Blyde River Canyon. Positioned at the convergence of three conservation areas—the Mariepskop Forest Reserve, Mariepskop State Forest, and the Blyde River Canyon Nature Reserve—this majestic summit offers a haven for nature enthusiasts.

Embark on the trail commencing at the beginning of the cement road leading to the SAAF. A steep incline spanning 700 meters marks the commencement of the Bushpig trail, with subsequent sections featuring a relatively gentle gradient. Traverse through diverse landscapes, including indigenous forest, pine forest, and open veld, providing a varied hiking experience.

Mariepskop's rich avian biodiversity enhances the journey, captivating birdwatchers with over 46 species on the farm. Among the notable bird residents are the European Honey-buzzard, Yellow Fronted Tinkerbird, White-faced Whistling Duck, and many more, creating a paradise for those who appreciate the symphony of nature.

Traverse low over citrus farms, gracefully navigating the twists and turns of the Olifants River Gorge while relishing the dramatic views. The pilot will touch down at an exclusive location, accessible only by aerial transport, where you can enjoy a catered picnic complete with sparkling and still water. 
