Not available Dec – May. Ngorongoro Crater: 3.5 to 4 hour drive to Mwiba, enquire for rates. Not available Dec – May. Fly with Coastal Aviation, Air Excel, Regional Air or Auric Air for in-seat flights. Private charters available.
Opening Dates	Open all year except from 01 Apr – 15 May.
Helicopter pad	Available by prior arrangement. Booking prior to arrival is essential.


