A tented sanctuary set amid golden grasses, Nyasi Tented Camp sets you in the thick of the surrounding wilderness — fostering a closer connection with nature.

Located in the Lamai Wedge in the northern reaches of the Serengeti, Nyasi affords guests seamless access to the Mara River – the iconic location of the wildebeest crossings. Experience a front row seat to the procession of more than two million wildebeest, zebra and Thomson's gazelle as they traverse across the vast grass plains.


DINING
