The Great Wildebeest Migration is one of Nature's most awesome spectacles, and it takes place each year in the Mara/Serengeti ecosystem. In fact, it's a continuous cycle of births, movements and deaths, all taking place on a vast scale, and with an incredible concentration of drama and emotion.

No matter how many wildlife documentaries you may have watched, nothing can quite prepare you for the dust, noise and sheer scale of the Migration, as hundreds of thousands of wildebeest and tens of thousands of zebra march incessantly onwards in search of fresh grazing.

Along the way, they must run the gauntlet of the Mara's resident predators, and navigate the river crossings (complete with huge Nile crocodiles) that represent perhaps the greatest hazard to each antelope or zebra.

The Great Wildebeest Migration takes place against the backdrop of the vast plains of the Mara, meaning you can experience a combination of iconic landscapes and breath-taking action.

This particular safari is focused on a specific location and event, but can be combined with other Kenyan safari highlights to create a longer Kenyan holiday. One great option would be to add the serenity of time on the beach to contrast with the exhilaration of this wildlife-focused adventure. Day 1 | Basecamp Masai Mara

- Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, where a Saruni Basecamp vehicle will transfer you to Wilson Airport for your charter flight to the Masai Mara.
- Depart Nairobi in the morning*, arriving in the Mara around an hour later, where your Saruni Basecamp guide will meet you to begin your first Mara game drive.
- Enjoy lunch in camp, then relax through the heat of the day as you watch wildlife from the comfort of your luxury tent, or the main area of the camp.
- Enjoy an afternoon game drive with your Maasai guide, in search of the Mara's resident wildlife, followed by dinner in camp.

Days 2 & 3 | Basecamp Masai Mara

- Enjoy an early start with breakfast in camp before a thrilling all-day vehicle safari in the Masai Mara National Reserve, on the trail of the restless migrating herds.
- Experience the drama of a river crossing, as wildebeest try to escape the snapping jaws of the crocodiles.
- Capture incredible photographs and watch unforgettable wildlife action.
- After a remarkable day, return to the camp to relive your day over dinner or around the fire.

















Day 4 | Basecamp Masai Mara

- Immerse yourself in the camp's eco-initiatives and community upliftment projects, including the Enjoolata Awareness Centre where you can learn more about Maasai culture, and purchase authentic Maasai artisanal products. You can also plant a tree to help offset the carbon your trip has generated (in return for a small donation).
- Enjoy meals in camp, and the chance to relax after the drama of the previous two days spent watching the Migration.

Day 5 | Departure

- A final morning game drive, focusing on learning about the role of the herds in the greater Mara ecosystem. Return to camp for breakfast, before an opportunity to pack and prepare for your onward journey before lunch and the ground transfer to Olkiombo airstrip for your flight back to Nairobi.
- Your flight leaves the Mara at 11:00* and arrives in Nairobi at 12:20*.
- Saruni Basecamp transfer* to Jomo Kenyatta
 International Airport, with the option of dinner at either
 Talisman or Carnivore. Bookings will be dependent on your flight times, with dinner on your own account.
