

# A JOINT VENTURE WITH THE LOCAL COMMUNITY, SABLE ALLEY IS A LIGHT, BRIGHT AND BEAUTIFULLY SOPHISTICATED CAMP AMID THE GAME-RICH FLOODPLAINS OF KHWAI PRIVATE RESERVE.

## WHERE IS SABLE ALLEY

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Sable Alley is located in the 200,000 hectare Khwai Private Reserve concession, overlooking vast floodplains. Red lechwe, waterbuck and reedbuck along with many antelope species are full time residents, whilst sightings of lion, leopard, spotted hyena and wild dog are excellent. Elephants abound and very quickly become an all-time favourite.

#### WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Sable Alley is open all year round with excellent game viewing. Water levels are highest in April to October for exploring on mokoros and boats. At other times of year, water activities may be restricted.

Dry season: April – October

Green season: November – March Please see our rates sheet for detailed information on seasons & pricing.

#### **HOW DO I GET THERE**

Direct flights are available to Maun from Cape Town and Johannesburg. Fly to Maun and then switch to a light aircraft to fly to our airstrip in the Khwai Reserve. Road transfers from Maun and self-drive options are available – please contact us for details.

#### WHERE WILL I STAY

There are 10 twin/double tents and 2 family tents with 1 double and 2 single beds, all have ceiling fans and are ensuite with indoor and outdoor showers. Tents are raised on decks with a private veranda.

#### WHAT WILL I EAT

Our wonderful chefs have a reputation for their good, wholesome meals. Please let us know of any dietary requirements prior to arrival.

#### **FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES**

Airstrip transfers, all meals, daily activities, local drinks and laundry are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature and personal travel insurance are excluded.

#### WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

The enormous main area boasts a lounge, several cosy seating areas, a bar, fire pit and swimming pool, all with views of the lagoon ahead. The camp is solar-powered with a back-up generator.

#### WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- We welcome children 6 yrs and older, (please refer to our rates for child policies).
- Wi-Fi is available in camp.
- Charging facilities are available in the rooms and main area.
- Our vehicles are open and accommodate
   7 guests.
- We can accommodate a maximum of 28 guests in camp.

**NOTE:** Road transfers to Skybeds will be charged at an extra per person rate.

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#### WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

#### Year Round:

- Morning & afternoon game drives.
- Mokoro safaris (water-level dependent).
- Walking safaris.
- Visit our underground hides on request, by helicopter. (At an additional cost).
- Helicopter flights over the Okavango Delta. (At an additional cost).
- Fishing: 01 Mar 31 Dec (no fishing permitted | Jan Feb due to breeding season).
- Be part of the KPR Ranger Experience and spend time tracking predators, capturing data, patrolling and if time allows visiting conservation projects. (At an additional cost. Proceeds of which will be allocated to conservation efforts in KPR).

#### **Dry Season:**

- Boating safaris (water-level dependent).
- Sleep out under the stars at Skybeds.

  Must be pre-booked. Open 1 April 31 October.

Children 15 years & older are welcome at Skybeds.

Children 6 years & older may take part in a mokoro or boat safari.

Children under 12 must wear a life jacket on a mokoro or boat.
