

## About Ngorongoro Crater

The jewel in Ngorongoro's crown is a deep, volcanic crater. This highly visited African attraction is the world's largest inactive, unbroken and unfilled volcanic caldera. About 20 kms across, 600 meters deep and 300 sq kms in area, the Ngorongoro Crater is a breathtaking natural wonder.

The Ngorongoro Crater is one of Africa's most famous sites and is said to have the highest density of wildlife in Africa. Due to the enclosed nature of the Crater it has virtually formed its own ecosystem.

The area contains over 25,000 large animals including black rhinoceros. There are 7,000 wildebeests, 4,000 zebras, 3,000 eland and 3,000 Grant's and Thomson's gazelles.

The crater also has the densest known population of lions, numbering 62. Higher up, in the rainforests of the crater rim, are leopards, about 30 large elephants, mountain reedbuck and more than 4,000 buffalos, spotted hyenas, jackals, rare wild dogs, cheetahs, and other felines.

## Travel Information

SEASON: Lions Paw Ngorongoro Camp is Open All Year Round.
WEATHER: Ngorongoro CA has a mild climate. The crater never gets too hot during the day, the crater however, does get very cold at night.

RAINFALL: The area experiences two season for rainfall. From October - November are the 'short' rains, followed by the 'long rains' from March to May.
TEMPERATURE: January is the hottest month of the year in Ngorongoro with an average temperature of $22^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\left(72^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\right)$ and the coldest is July at $18^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\left(64^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\right)$.

CURRENCY: USD, GBP, EUR, CHF, TZS. Only USD notes printed from 2006 onwards will be accepted. Visa and MasterCard are accepted.
