The al fresco dining area overlooks sweeping lawns to the babbling Boonties River and the wilderness beyond.

Embers

Traditional South African Braai (BBQ) under African skies. Built into a natural sandstone amphitheatre, Embers perched on a dramatic cliff and overlooks the spectacular valley below. A truly magical atmosphere.

ACCOMMODATION

SUITE (1)

Set within the restored Manor House, dating back to 1843, the spacious Suite is brimming with vintage African charm. Perfumed by the traditional thatch roof and filled with antique furniture and original artworks, the Paterson Suite offers a spacious ensuite master bedroom, complete with a four-poster bed, leading onto a private verandah.
