



## **Greetings Birders!**

The following is a list of the 608 bird species that have been recorded for Sacha Lodge, since observations began in 1991. In addition to the birds found on Sacha Lodge property, recorded in transit on the Napo River, and around Coca, those seen on the trails South of the Napo River (Nuevo Providencia, Anangu) have also been included.

In regions of amazingly high biodiversity, such as we have here, numbers of individuals of a given species (density) may be low, but the variety of species that may be seen is astounding. Some of the birds on the list are rarely encountered or have only been observed once or twice, though one should not be surprised if one or two common species are missed, and replaced by one or two which are typically very rare. Numerous species that occur here are migrants, both Boreal and Austral, and are, therefore, seen only during certain times of year. Alongside each listing is important information which may help distinguish birds in the field, including relative abundance, habitat, and migratory status.

It is important to remember that no list is ever complete or absolute. The locations of birds sighted at Sacha may certainly vary and change, and there are undoubtedly more species yet you to find. **Abu (abundance):** A - Abundant; recorded approximately 10/10 visits to proper habitat  
C - Common; recorded approximately 7/10 visits to proper habitat  
U - Uncommon; recorded approximately 5/10 visits to proper habitat  
R - Rare; recorded approximately 1 to 5 annually  
1 - Extremely rare; recorded approximately 1 to 5 times in the history of observations here at Sacha Lodge  
nt - Near-threatened, according to The World List of Threatened Birds (Collar et al., 1994)  
e - Endangered, according to the List of Birds Threatened with Extinction in Ecuador (Granizo et al., 1997)  
v - Vulnerable, according to the List of Birds Threatened With Extinction in Ecuador (Granizo et al., 1997)

**Loc (locality):** T - recorded most frequently from the Wooden Tower and Canopy Walk  
A - Has only been observed along the trails on the South side of the Napo river.  
(A) - Has been recorded on Sacha property North of the Napo, but can only be expected on the South side of the Napo River.  
H - Heard more often than seen

**Hab (habitat):** T - Terra Firme forest  
V - Varzea; forest periodically flooded by white water from the Napo  
I - Islands, riverbanks and the gallery forest of the Napo River  
L - Blackwater lagoons such as Pilchecochoa  
C - Blackwater creeks and interior forest streams, such as Orquidea Creek  
S - Secondary Forest, cultivated areas, and pasture  
F - In Flight, over varied habitats

**Mig (migrant):** N - Boreal migrant coming in from the North, mainly seen from September to April  
S - Austral migrant coming in from the South, mainly seen from April to September  
? - Applies most to species that migrate within the Amazon Basin itself and those few species that have East to West migration patterns. Can be erratic.

## Appendices

**Both appendices (Appendix A, Appendix B) will follow the main list as separate text. Appendix A is a taxonomic list of the birds recorded in the Coca area, by visiting birders and guides. These are not included in the Main List, as the Main List applies to those species recorded on Sacha property itself. Appendix B is a list of the birds removed from the main text due to the extreme unlikelihood that they will be encountered again, or because the sighting is questionable in nature. These species should by no means be expected by the visiting birders, though they are**

worthy of mention, nonetheless. If recorded and confirmed, in the future, these species may be upgraded to the Main List.
