

## SUGGESTED SAFARI

## Day 1 Lewa Wilderness

- Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, where a Saruni Basecamp vehicle will transfer you to Wilson Airport for your flight to Lewa Downs.
- Depart Nairobi's Wilson airport for your one-hour morning\* flight to Lewa. You'll be met on arrival and transferred to Lewa Wilderness, enjoying an initial game drive en route. Depending on your arrival time, you can either enjoy lunch and an afternoon of discovering Lewa Conservancy, or sundowners followed by a candlelit dinner.

## Day 2 Lewa Wilderness

- Choose how you'd like to experience Lewa Wilderness, with a huge variety of activities on offer. These include everything from traditional game drives to horse riding and camel safaris, as well as guided bush walks with skilled local guides.
- Meals are served in the lodge to take advantage of the picturesque views, or as picnics enjoyed out in the Lewa Conservancy.

## Day 3 | Lewa Wilderness

- As well as activities bringing you closer to the wildlife, be sure to take part in a 'behindthe-scenes' visit of the Lewa Conservancy's conservation activities. This will give you incredible insights into how this precious ecosystem.
- Alternatively, you can add a dash of Hollywood to your safari with a memorable scenic flight in the 'Out of Africa' Waco biplane (payable extra).



















## Day 4 | Saruni Mara / Saruni Wild

- Depart Lewa Downs on your morning\* flight, arriving in the Masai Mara just 90 minutes later.
- Set off on a game drive with a pause for a picnic lunch under an iconic acacia tree or by the river next to a pod of hippos, or head to Saruni Mara or Saruni Wild to relax before an afternoon game drive in the exclusive Mara North Conservancy – over 30,000 acres of prolific, protected land bordering the Masai Mara National Reserve. This part of the Mara ecosystem offers remarkable game viewing and a rewarding sense of seclusion.

## Day 5 | Saruni Mara / Saruni Wild

- Start your day with a game drive focused on looking for the big cats and other well-known predators of the Mara, returning to the camp or lodge for lunch and treatments at the Maasai Wellbeing Space.
- In the afternoon, explore different areas of the conservancy and add new species to your Mara checklist before dinner at the lodge or camp and then an optional night drive.

## Day 6 | Saruni Mara / Saruni Wild

- Take a guided walk through the valleys and plains surrounding Saruni Mara, accompanied by a vehicle, or head to the summit of Kilileoni, the highest mountain in the Serengeti-Masai Mara ecosystem.
- In the afternoon, discover more of Mara North and its neighbouring conservancies and experience firsthand what makes the Mara one of the most exciting conservation destinations in the world.
- Weather permitting, experience a bush dinner in the middle of nature under the vast African sky, accompanied by traditional Maasai singing and dancing around the fire.

## Day 7 | Departure

- Breakfast in camp, before a last opportunity to visit the rhino sanctuary on the way to the airstrip for your 11:00 return flight to Nairobi from the Mara.
- Saruni Basecamp transfer\* to Jomo Kenyatta
   International Airport, with the option of dinner at either
   Talisman or Carnivore. Bookings will be dependent on your flight times, with dinner on your own account.
