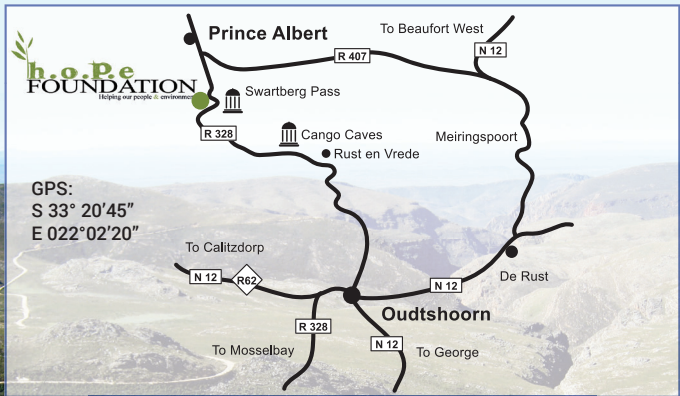
Ascending 950 meters above the Cango Valley the 27 kilometer Swartberg Pass winds to the summit 1 583 meters above sea level, in steep zig-zags and sudden switchbacks, with breath-taking views over the Klein- and Great Karoo. Built by Thomas Bain, the pass was declared a National Monument in its centenary year 1988.
