Imagine falling asleep to the symphony of the bush, rising with the sun to join our master guides as we explore wildest Africa.

Pafuri is our flagship camp, featuring:

- Twelve en-suite luxury tents for couples or singles
- Seven en-suite luxury tents for families of up to four
- A bush bar and swimming pool

- Breakfast, high tea and dinner served on the deck above the river
- Local food and dance experiences in the Makuleke village

PAFURI WALKING TRAILS

See untamed Africa from a new perspective. Our walking trails wind through the remotest corners of the Kruger, giving you the chance to stumble upon the Big Five in their untouched habitat. For the truly adventurous, we occasionally offer minimalist trails that wander across borders into the transfrontier park, where you'll sleep under the stars and feel totally removed from civilisation - yet perhaps closest to yourself.

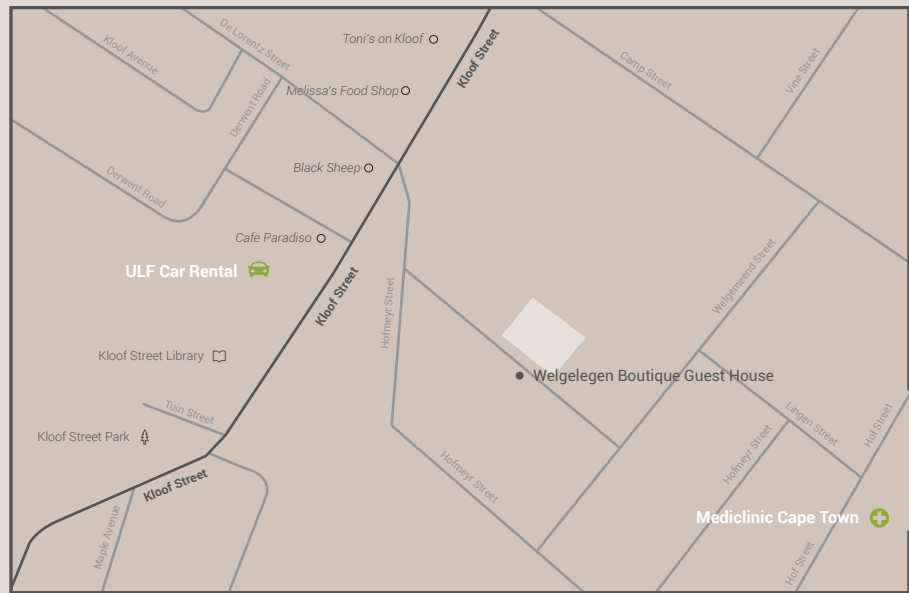
