WARWICK FIRST LADY
SAUVIGNON BLANC

South Africa

Zesty with a beautiful balance of cut grass and Granny Smith apples layered with tropical notes of granadilla and pineapple and a lingering citrus finish.

PAUL DE VILLIERS
CHENIN BLANC

South Africa

The wine displays a complex of flavours and aromas with citrus and peach being prominent, enhanced through fermentation and ageing in French oak barrels.

CHARDONNAY

The Iona Chardonnay shows concentrated marzipan and citrus flavours with underlying hazelnut and lime notes, which adds to layered complexity.

The nose shows a cascade of gooseberries, asparagus, and lemongrass, complemented by lush, juicy fruit. Well balanced with a full, rich palate and a lingering finish.

SPIER 21 GABLES
CHENIN BLANC

Soft aromas of dried apricots and ripe tropical fruit, with an oak and vanilla undertow on the nose. On the palate, there’s an inescapable rounded richness of flavour and good acidity, white flesh peaches, almond paste and creamy notes.

CHARDONNAY

The essence of capturing complexity drives the flavour profile of this Chardonnay. Structured with many layered flavour components arising from combinations of best French Oak, yeast, lees contact and finest fruit, which all reward the palate with a kaleidoscope of tastes. This pleasing palate adventure offers hints of litchi, white peach, kiwi fruit, strawberry smoothie and golden tangerine combining to generate a memorable taste experience with a creamy, lingering finish.

KLEINE ZALZE
FAMILY RESERVE
SAUVIGNON BLANC

This full, but elegant Sauvignon Blanc is delicate, fresh and perfumed, with kiwi, gooseberries and “kakie bos” on the nose and a mineral edge on the palate.

KEN FORRESTER FMC
CHENIN BLANC

This Chenin Blanc is rich, seductive, and very sophisticated. Layer upon layer of candied lemon, dried apricot, and vanilla, with a touch of honey and spice, effortlessly supported by gentle oak, and a lovely freshness.

RED WINES

SUTHERLAND
PINOT NOIR

South Africa

This Pinot Noir was aged in French oak barrels for 9 months and shows pure strawberry fruit aromas and lovely perfumed spice and earthy characters on the nose. The wine is wonderfully balanced with a long, refined finish.

DIEMERSFONTEIN
PINOTAGE

Diemersfontein Pinotage emanates rich flavours of dark red fruit like mulberry and blackberry on the nose, followed by strawberry, cherry and plum on the palate all wrapped in a subtle hint of a well-balanced oak component.

This wine has an attractive but complex bouquet of plum, red berries and white pepper flavours. It is well balanced with layers of dark fruit and spices, complemented by well-integrated tannins and vanilla flavours, a chocolate bouquet with a long finish.

GALPHIN PEAK
PINOT NOIR

A confident wine with a firm and polished profile of flavours without being overstated. Peppery spice with blackberry and cherry notes, ending in a harmonious and long earthy finish.

FAIRVIEW
MERLOT

Ruby red colour with raspberry, mocha and vanilla pod aromas. Medium-bodied with supple tannins, fresh red fruit flavours with a harmonious finish.

BOEKENHOUTSKLOOF

The wine is savoury, almost Rhône-like in style with integrated acidity and firm, fine-grained tannins to balance. The spicy finish endures with hints of cloves, nutmeg and cardamom and subtle garrigue nuances.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON**

The wine was matured for 18 months and offers aromas of black currant, dark cherry, graphite, and exotic spice. The exceptionally balanced wine offers to taste notes of blueberry, bay leaf and a precise finish with hints of raw cocoa.

This elegant Rhône blend displays Old World Style with New World fruit. Hint of Grenache’s earthy rusticity and Shiraz’s noble spice with hints of nutmeg and salty black olive on the finish. Balanced with soft integrated tannins.

The exquisitely expressive De Toren Fusion V unveils intense aromas of juicy red cherries and ripe blueberries. It further compels with supporting nuances of perfume, creamy notes of cassis and an understated, underlining chalky minerality.

Blackcurrants, fynbos herbs, graphite filing and an undertow of supporting oak. Rich complex flavours which slowly unwind from a firm core. A blend of fruit, blueberries, roadside brambles and cassis. Beautiful full palate with well-integrated tannins. Perfect harmony from entry to the long dry elegant aftertaste.



ROSE WINES

PIERRE JOURDAN TRANQUILLE PINOT NOIR

South Africa

Blended to be fresh and vibrant, expect tropical fruit, red berries and lime on the nose, which follows through perfectly on the palate. The Chardonnay adds a zesty lime character, with the Pinot Noir being fruit-forward, which allows for a lingering finish.

WARWICK THE FIRST LADY ROSE

This wine presents itself in delicate pink, the nose immediately picks up the smell of raspberry and the fine floral note of jasmine. Delicately pink, bursting with pomegranate, strawberry and watermelon. Bone dry, yet soft and lush.

SPARKLING WINES

GRAHAM BECK BRUT

South Africa

This wine has a unique pale silver-pink hue. Aromas of raspberries, cherries and a few secondary whiffs of minerality. A lively mousse, but fine in the mouth, with subtle red berry flavours enlivened by bright acidity. Brisk, yet delicate on the palate, bursting with flavours of freshly crushed berries and hints of oyster shell.

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KEN FORRESTER SPARKLEHORSE

Made by the Cap Classique or traditional method, this wine aged for 18 months on lees to develop a creaminess and delicate mousse while still maintaining bright, fresh apple, pear and quince aromas.

PROSECCO & FRENCH CHAMPAGNE

BOLLA PROSECCO

The Bolla Prosecco begins with a very pleasant aroma featuring light citrus notes, pear, green apple, and honeysuckle. Tasting reveals similar flavours to the nose in this extra dry (not sweet) sparkler. You will also find fizz, a slightly creamy texture and good acidity.

MOËT & CHANDON MOËT IMPÉRIAL BRUT

France

This champagne has a creamy and fresh mousse, with biscuity hints of stone fruits, and aromas of brioche, citrus and white stone fruits.
