Ngaga Lodge

Essence

Hidden in a dense, nearly inaccessible forest, Ngaga is one of Africa's most remarkable lodges, offering the rare opportunity to visit gorillas in a habitat barely touched by humanity. Ngaga is home to a primatology research team whose members have spent decades observing the gorilla families, navigating their trails, and understanding the forest's rhythms; guests can share in their knowledge while experiencing the intact ecosystem.

Location

Ndzehi Concession, on the western boundary of Odzala-Kokoua National Park, Republic of the Congo.

Ngaga Lodge

Lodge Facilities

- 6 twin/double bungalows nestled on stilts overlooking the dense forest.
- Bungalows constructed from natural materials such as locally woven raffia palm fronds.
- A dining room, lounge, and bar area on raised platforms and gazing into the rainforest.
- Star deck and fire pit on a deck below the main living/dining area for pre-dinner drinks at sunset
- River deck on the Ngaga stream for post-walk sundowners and special occasions
- Limited Wi-Fi

Room Details

- Raised 3-4 meters (10-13 feet) above the ground
- 360° wraparound walkway
- En-suite bathroom with hot shower & flush toilet
- Mosquito net
- Environmentally friendly soaps and shampoos
- Ceiling fans (no air-conditioning)
- European plug points
- In-room safe

Lango Lodge

Essence

With one of the most spectacular settings of any lodge in Africa, Lango places you at the secluded heart of the Congolese rainforest. Suspended above a bai where elephants, buffalo, and other wildlife come to bathe, feed, and socialize, the lodge offers arresting views and unparalleled access to a pristine ecosystem. Time here is about getting in touch with the pristine landscape – and also getting wet and a little muddy.

Location

Located on Lango Bai in the south central part of Odzala-Kokoua National Park, allowing easy access to a variety of habitats.

Lango Lodge

Lodge Facilities

- 6 twin/double bungalows nestled on stilts in the dense forest overlooking Lango Bai
- Bungalows constructed from natural materials such as locally woven raffia palm fronds
- Lodge connected by a series of raised walkways, creating a treehouse-like atmosphere
- Dining room, lounge, and bar area on the main deck overlooking the bai.
- Star deck and fire pit perfectly positioned for pre-dinner drinks to watch the sunset and observe wildlife on the bai
- Limited Wi-Fi

Room Details

- Raised 3-4 meters (10-13 feet) above the ground
- 360° wraparound walkway
- En-suite bathroom with hot shower & flush toilet
- Mosquito net
- Environmentally friendly soaps and shampoos
- Ceiling fans (no air-conditioning)
- European plug points
- In-room safe

Mboko Lodge

Essence

Set at the intersection of savanna, forest, and river, Mboko provides a front-row seat to the staggering diversity of the Congolese ecosystem. Hyena prowl across open grasslands while monkeys tussle in the trees. Nearby waterways beckon with the promise of mesmerizing beauty and rare wildlife sightings. Every day at Mboko brings a new adventure and a sense of magical calm.

Location

The southern half of Odzala-Kokoua National Park, midway between Kamba's private airstrip and the Lekoli River boat launch.

Mboko Lodge

Lodge Facilities

- 6 double/twin bungalows set among the trees along the Likeni River
- Dining room, lounge, and bar area in an open pavilion overlooking the wide-open grasslands
- Star deck and fire pit extend off the living areas, the ideal space for pre-dinner drinks and to scan the horizon for lightning storms
- River deck and screened-in parlor located along the Likeni River for post-walk swims, sundowners, or special occasions

Room Details

- Spacious rooms decorated with works by local artisans.
- Private furnished, screened-in porch or veranda overlooking the river.
- En-suite bathroom with hot shower & flush toilet
- Mosquito net
- Environmentally friendly soaps and shampoos
- Ceiling fans (no air-conditioning)
- European plug points
- In-room safe
