Italian

Fried eggs on toast, with basil pesto and
mozzarella cheese.

Canadian

Four mini-pancakes served with maple syrup-
bananas and mixed berries.

French

Two slices of French toast, served with honey
and grated cheese.

Scottish

Steaming bowl of oat meal porridge, served
with honey, brown sugar and a tot of single
malt scotch on the side.

International

Two egg omelette with a choice of fillings:
Cheese, tomato, ham, onions, green peppers
and mushrooms
served with white or brown toast.

Did you know...?

...that Namibia is the second *least densely* populated country on earth?

Population: 2,259,000 people (2012)

Capital: Windhoek, which means "windy corner" in Afrikaans is the country's biggest city with around 322,000 inhabitants.

Namibia Exports: diamonds, copper, gold, zinc, lead, uranium, cattle, processed fish, karakul skins

The *Namib Desert* is the oldest desert in the world. The dunes range from 100m to 388m high and are amongst the tallest dunes in the world dunes.

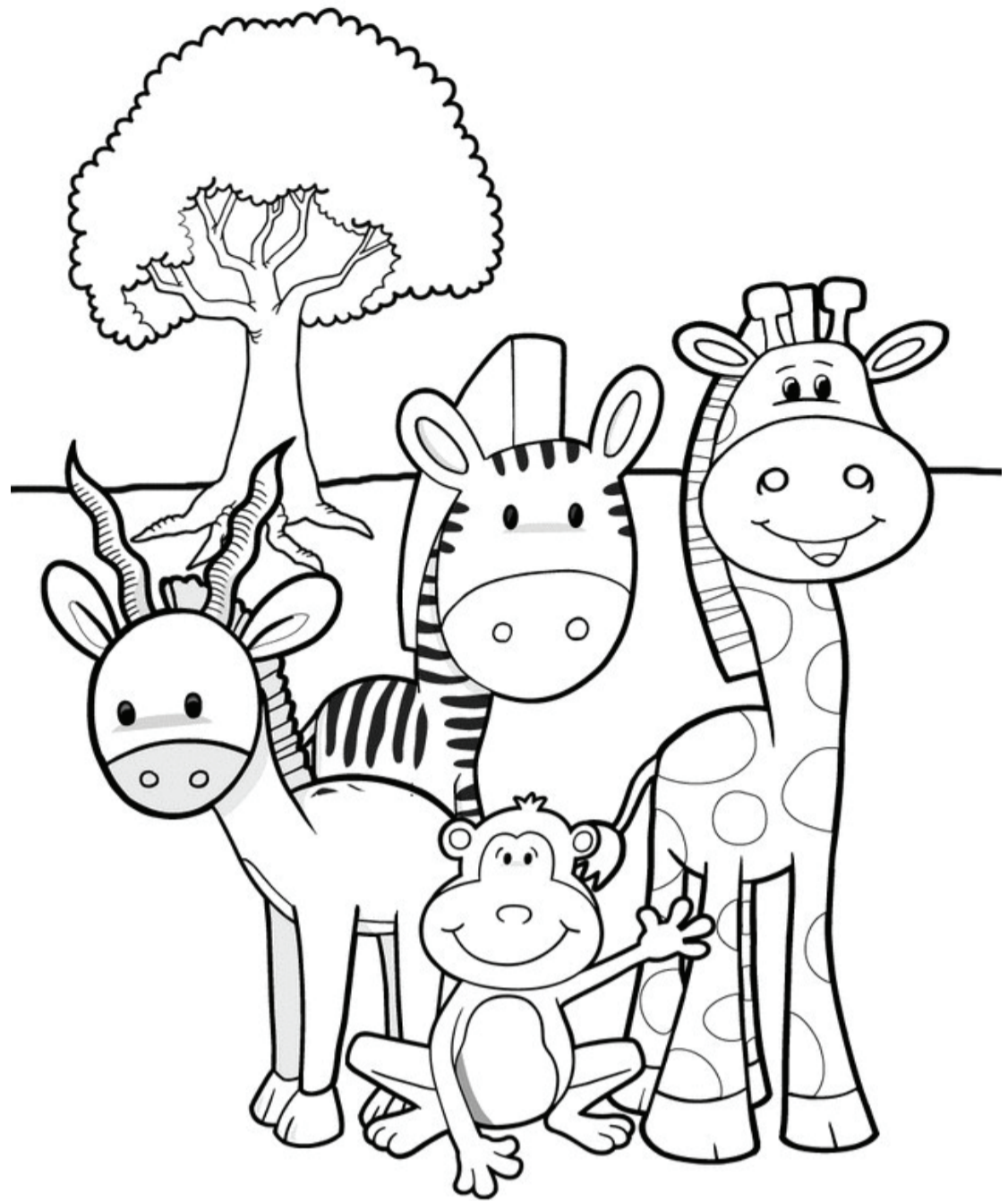
At *Sossusvlei* you will notice the sand colour range from grey to red. The older the dune is, the more red it will appear.

The scorched black trees in *Deadvlei* are over 900 years old and are only standing because the wood is too dry to decompose.

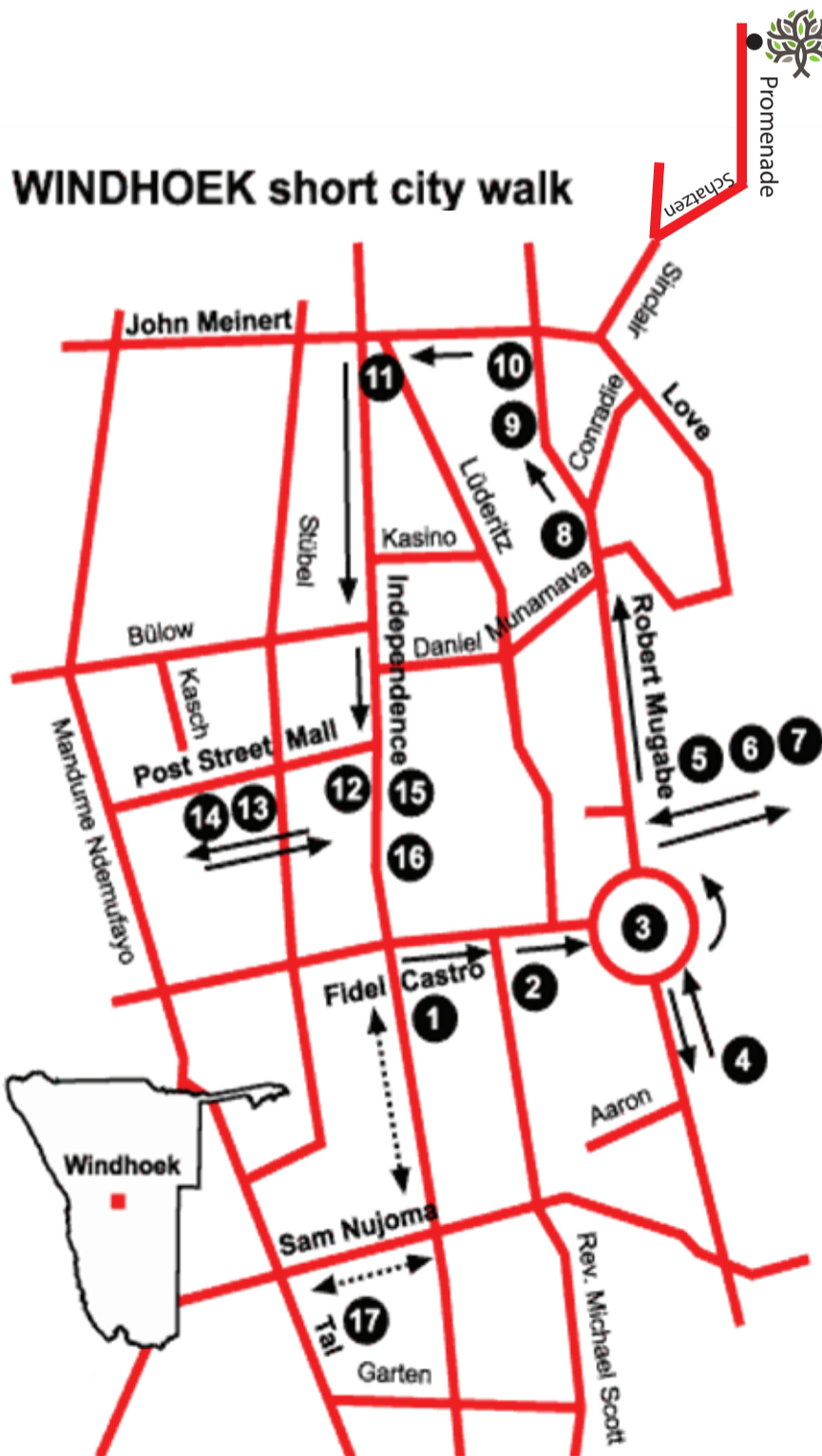
Stunning *Fish River Canyon* is the second largest canyon in the world, after the Grand Canyon.

In the language of the Ovambo tribe, *Etosha* means 'great white place'. The Etosha pan is so large it can be seen from space. It is the only known mass breeding ground for flamingos in Namibia. At times there can be around 1 million flamingos in the pan.

The following walk is suitable for half a day or less. It covers the main attractions in and around the central business district. The walk follows a circular route that highlights the main attractions, museums & galleries and allow for shopping and refreshments, along the main street, Independence Avenue, and on the Post Street Mall. You will encounter numerous shops and cafés along the route. Enjoy your walk!

- 1.) Begin the walk at the intersection of Fidel Castro Street and Independence Avenue, looking east, up the hill. The Christuskirche will be visible, about 200m up the hill. Walk up the hill towards the church.
- 2.) The Estorff Building
- 3.) The Christuskirche
- 4.) The Reiter Denkmal
- 6.) Parliament Garden
- 7.) At the top of the steps leading up to the parliament, three statues depict heroes of the Namibian liberation struggle, Hendrick Witbooi, Hosea Kutako and Theophilus Hingashikuka Hamutumbangela.
- 8.) The 'Tintenpalast'
- 9.) The Owela Museum
- 10.) The National Theatre
- 11.) The National Gallery
- 12.) The Kudu Statue
- 13.) Post Street Mall
- 14.) The Gibeon Meteorites
- 15.) Areas of the Post Street Mall have been demarcated for craft sellers and other informal enterprises. Wooden carvings, wire
- 16.) Zoo Park in Independence Avenue
- 17.) The Craft Centre
