





About Lalibela:

- Size: 10,500 hectares (approximately 26,000 acres).
- Game: Big 5 (lion, elephant, rhino, buffalo and leopard) as well as other predators like cheetah, hyena, jackal and lynx.
- Unique Selling Points:
 - ✤ Malaria free game reserve.
 - 1 Lalibela has prolific game numbers and boasts one of the densest population of free roaming lions in South Africa.
- Location:
 - Lalibela main reception is 90 km / 55 miles from Port Elizabeth tarred road all the way.
 - ✤ Lalibela Kichaka reception is 100 km by tar and 3 km of gravel road.



Game activities:

- Morning and evening game drives (times seasonally adjusted). Evening game drives usually return to the lodge after dark.
- Off road driving permitted for Big 5 sightings.
- Guided game walks:
 - ✤ Big 5 walks (Ages 16 70).
 - 🕆 Soft walks in non-Big 5 area (All ages).
 - ✤ Weather dependent therefore book during your stay.
 - ✤ Bush walks are an additional cost. Guests to settle direct with the lodge.
- Night drives:
 - ♥ Optional late-night game drives by arrangement with the lodge at an additional cost.

Arrival and departure:

- Check in: 12h00 13h00
- Check out: 11h00
- Guests are transferred from reception to their lodge in a Lalibela vehicle.
- Road transfers to and from Port Elizabeth Airport By arrangement.
- Secure parking at reception.
- Lalibela is easily accessible with a standard rental car. There is no need to hire a SUV / 4 X 4 vehicle.
- Kichaka guests check in at a dedicated Kichaka reception.

Rates:

- Includes: Accommodation, all meals, teas and coffees, all drinks (excludes premium wines and spirits) and two game drives per night stayed.
- Excludes: A conservation levy of R 150 (2023 & 2024) per adult per night, transfers, gratuities and items of a personal nature.
