
- + Open 20 May to 15 Nov

The start of the walking safari season, which runs from May to November.



September to November is best for seeing the iconic carmine bee-eaters.

Best chances to see rare serval and caracals In September and October.



JUL MUL

Lion sightings pick up as the bush gets drier.



Peak season for our signature Sleepout Under the Stars is July to October.


