## STANDARD TERMS & CONDITIONS

(Please refer to the additional group terms that apply to bookings of 3+ rooms)

### Provisional Bookings

- Provisional bookings will initially be held for a period of 14 days. We reserve the right to release any space not confirmed within this period without notice. Shorter hold times will apply when we have limited space and for enquiries made close to travel.
- On occasion we are happy to hold space for an extended period. Should another party need space we are holding for you, a decision to confirm must be made within 48 hours or the space will be released.

### Confirmation & Payment

- Deposits:
  - To confirm, a non-refundable deposit of 20% of the total booking value is to be paid within 14 days of confirmation.
  - Flights booked on your behalf will be invoiced in full at the time of confirmation for payment alongside the deposit.
- Balance payments:
  - The final balance will be payable 45 days prior to the date of arrival.
- Payments are to be made via bank transfer to the account details supplied on your confirmation summary.
- Kindly note that all bank charges must be covered by the payer to ensure the full, invoiced amount is received. Any shortfall owing to intermediary banks will be deemed payable.

### Cancellation Policy

- From date of confirmation – 46 days, cancellation will be charged at 20% of the total booking value.
- From 45 – 0 days, cancellation will be charged at 100% of the total booking value.
- Please note any third-party services booked on your behalf are subject to the specific cancellation terms of the supplier.**
- Ticketed flights are non-refundable.
- Any refunds will incur a \$200 handling and administration fee.

### General notes

- Upon confirmation guests are expected to arrange a comprehensive travel insurance policy providing each traveller with full medical, cancellation and curtailment coverage. Details of this must be provided to us prior to travel.
- Please note that the company are unable to take responsibility for external events that may result in travel delays or cancellations. The guest is responsible for any and all costs that arise as a result of last-minute changes to itineraries.

## CHILD POLICY

- Shenton Safaris classifies a child as 12 years and below.
- Children receive 25% off the nightly rates (normal WP apply). The third child in a family booking stays free of charge with only the nightly levies to pay.
- Children at all camps, and in all room types, must share with at least one adult.
- Families travelling with children under 12 are required to book and pay for a private guide and vehicle.
- Kaingo Standard Rooms
  - Minimum age 8 years
  - Families of 3 sharing a standard room are required to book and pay for a private guide and vehicle.
- Kaingo First House
  - Minimum age 6 years
  - Two-bedroom family suite with private dining, plus private guide and vehicle (3 bench) as standard.
- Mwamba Bushcamp
  - Minimum age 12 years
  - Families of 3 sharing a standard room are required to book and pay for a private guide and vehicle.
  - Families wishing to stay at Mwamba with children under 12 must book all rooms for exclusive camp use. Minimum age on request
- Please note we operate in wild, unfenced areas. Adults are responsible for supervising children at all times. Regretfully we are not able to offer child minding services.

## GROUP BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

(The following terms apply in addition to our standard booking terms and conditions)

- Shenton Safaris classifies any booking of 3 or more rooms as a group (regardless of occupancy per room)
- Max 2 single room rates per group. Any additional single rooms will be charged at double occupancy rates.

### Group Provisional bookings

- Shenton Safaris are able to provisionally hold a pre-arranged number of rooms on an extended provisional basis.
- Should another party need space we are holding for you, a decision to confirm the required room(s) must be made within 48 hours or the space will be released.
- For book-on to tours / groups where the final number of travellers is unknown, we are regretfully not able to offer long provisional holds for travel between 01 September - 15 October.

### Group Confirmation + Payment

- For book-on to tours / groups where the final number of travellers is unknown, deposits are calculated on shared occupancy per room held. Should rooms be confirmed and then any be taken for single occupancy, the rate difference will be carried over to the balance invoice.
- To confirm groups the following deposit structures, apply according to the time of travel.
  - For Low / Shoulder season and the last 2 weeks of October, a non-refundable deposit of 20% of the total booking value is payable within 14 days of confirmation.
  - For Aug to mid Oct, a non-refundable deposit of 50% of the total booking value is payable within 14 days of confirmation.
  - Flights booked on your behalf will be invoiced in full at the time of confirmation for payment alongside the deposit.
- Full balance payments are required no later than 60 days prior to the date of arrival.
- Payments are to be made via bank transfer to the account details supplied on your confirmation summary.
- Kindly note that all bank charges must be covered by the payer to ensure the full, invoiced amount is received.

### Group Cancellation Terms

- From confirmation to 61 days, cancellation will be charged at the applicable deposit amount.
- From 60 0 days, cancellation will be charged at 100% of the total booking value.
- Should any of the originally confirmed rooms fail to sell, the deposit paid for those rooms, will be forfeited.
- Please note any third-party services booked on your behalf are subject to the specific cancellation terms of the supplier.
- Ticketed flights are non-refundable.
- Any refunds will incur a \$200 handling and administration fee.

### Group Activities

- Shentons allocate 4 guests per vehicle as standard. For groups, the following applies based on the number of guest rooms (regardless of if the rooms are single or double):
  - 3 guest rooms Guarantees 1 private guide & vehicle (3 bench vehicle)
  - 6 guest rooms Guarantees minimum 2 private guides & vehicles (3 bench vehicle)
- Where numbers fall outside of the standard 4 per vehicle, groups have the option to increase capacity on their private vehicle (e.g., 6 per vehicle) or some of the group may share with other guests in camp.
- Additional private vehicles may also be reserved (chargeable and strictly subject to availability).
- Please note that Tour Leaders or Tour Leader rooms do not count towards vehicle allocation numbers.

### Getting to us

- Zambia's capital, Lusaka (LUN), is the main hub with daily access via several international airlines. Flights and road transfers from neighbouring countries can also be easily arranged into Livingstone (LVI).
- Our local airport, Mfuwe (MFU) is a 70 min flight from Lusaka (LUN) or 90 mins direct from Lower Zambezi airstrips Jeki (JEK) or Royal (RYL).
- We are happy to assist in booking domestic flights and transfers within Zambia, as well as other camps and lodges.

### Activity notes

- To help us ensure each guest gets the best out of their time in the bush, please be sure to inform reservations of game viewing interests when enquiring.
- Activities are shared with other guests. While we always endeavour to place like minded guests together, we strongly suggest anyone with specific game viewing interests such as serious photography or birding, enquire about booking a private guide and vehicle.
- We are only able to consider requests for specific guide's when a private guide is reserved. While we will always try to assist, requests are strictly subject to availability.

### Game drives

- Offered morning, afternoon & evening.
- Max 4 guests per vehicle (Our 3 bench vehicles can seat more when families / groups want to share)
- To maximise sightings / photographic opportunities, our game drive vehicles are un-shaded. Canopy's can be arranged when booking a private vehicle (shaded vehicles are used for airport transfers).

### Walking safaris

- Usually enjoyed in the mornings, with shorter mid-day and afternoon walks available.
- Max group size 6 guests (plus walking guide & armed scout).
- Min age 12 years.

### Photographic / Wildlife Hides

- Shenton Safaris are proud to offer exclusive use of several wildlife hides that can be enjoyed as a third daily activity.
  - Hippo Hide (For guests at Kaingo)
  - Carmine Bee-eater Hide (Available from both camps. Late August - October)
  - Elephant Hide (For guests at Kaingo)
  - Wild Dog Lagoon Hide (Available from both camps. May - August)
  - The 'Last Waterhole' Hide (For guests at Mwamba)
  - We also have mobile hides for special sightings (available from both camps)
- Please note hides are offered on a shared basis at all times, even when reserving a private guide & vehicle.

### Camp Schedule

- Check-in time is from 11.00 am. Check-out time is 09.30 am. Where availability allows, guests can arrive / depart outside of these times at no extra cost. Should rooms not be available for a late check-out, guests are welcome to remain in camp and join in mealtimes as per the normal schedule until their departure.
- Below is an example of a typical day in camp. Times vary slightly according to the season and all activities are optional:

### Safety

- Travel insurance is essential for all travellers. Guests are expected to arrange a comprehensive travel insurance policy that covers any medical, emergency evacuation and repatriation expenses (in addition to standard cover for cancelation, curtailment and personal belongings).
- Guests must inform the reservations and camp team of any relevant medical conditions or dietary restrictions. The guest is solely responsible for ensuring they carry an adequate supply of any medications and have consulted with their doctor prior to travel for health advice and recommendations when visiting Zambia.
- By confirming their safari, the guest acknowledges the potential risks and hazardous nature of an African Safari and agrees to sign an indemnity form.
