Dinner and overnighting at Mopani Rest camp 	Makapansgat (or Makapan Valley World Heritage Site) is an archaeological location within the Makapansgat and Zwartkrans Valleys, northeast of Mokopane in Limpopo province, South Africa. It is an important paleontological site, with the local lime works containing Australopithecus-bearing deposits dating to between 3.0 and 2.6 million years BP Regarded as a living museum, the Bakone Malapa Northern Sotho Open-Air Museum near Polokwane is one of several museums and national monuments that bear testimony to South Africa's peoples.

And Breakfast Return to your camp for a quick rest nap At your leisure within the camp Night drive with dinner at Kruger National park Overnighting at Mopani Rest camp 	Kruger National Park is a South African National Park and one of the largest game reserves in Africa. It covers an area of 19,485 km² (7,523 sq mi) in the provinces of Limpopo and Mpumalanga in northeastern South Africa, and extends 360 km (220 mi) from north to south and 65 km (40 mi) from east to west.	
Day 4	 Early breakfast at the restaurant Depart from Mopani to Pafuri camp for the tour. Depart at 09:am for Tour of the Thulamela camp Late lunch at restaurant in Pafuri Depart to Maphungubwe Loekwe camp for overnighting and dinner. 	Thulamela is a stone walled site is situated in the Far North region of the Park and dates back to approximately 450 – 500 years before present (BP). This late Iron Age site forms part of what is called the Zimbabwe culture which is believed to have started at Maphungubwe. Maphungubwe decline coincided with the increase of Great Zimbabwe's importance. When Great Zimbabwe was abandoned about 300 years later, possibly due to political break down, several groups moved south across the Limpopo river into the North Eastern areas of South Africa (and Northern Kruger) and established new smaller chiefdoms such as Thulamela. This is Mapungubwe's main camp, located in the eastern section of the Park in the spectacular sandstone hills

Visit the Shashe river that border Botswana/south Africa and Zimbabwe Depart to Kone Village Boutique Checking-Inn at Kone-Village Boutique Lodge for overnight and dinner	As part of this tour, you will be given the opportunity to visit the elite graveyard at the top of Maphungubwe Hill, view a natural amphitheater and the entire spectrum of the region, and traverse the territory once walked upon by the ancestral Maphungubwe People now roamed by four of the Big 5. The Museum Centre which is built near the main gate of the Maphungubwe National Park won the building of the year competition in 2009 and is home to the famous Golden Rhino. The Centre provides both day and over-night visitors the opportunity of a tour, showcasing the amazing landscape that the National Park has to offer.
